## Nebraska Hereford Tour Highlights

The Nebraska Hereford Association held a two-day tour of breeders in the central part of the state.

Beautiful weather and scenery along with an interesting lineup of breeders attracted between 150 and 200 people each day of the tour which was held September 10th and 11th.

These people pulled out all the stops to present their breeding programs and it proved

to be a very enjoyable two-day Hereford tour.

The first day started off at Linton Polled Herefords near Miller, NE with a display from Zero Hereford

Ranch. The Lintons have been raising Herefords since 1977. Their Hyalite prefix came from Hyalite Canyon in Bozeman, MT, where they and the herd lived for 13 years.

Lintons have been in their current location for 10 years and run about 80 head of mother cows. Bull calves are developed with commercial breeders in mind and are sold privately as yearlings. Their focus is performance and accurate EPDs and they stress calving ease, strong maternal traits, rapid growth and carcass merit without sacrificing functionality. The cowherd consists of a great deal of Felton breeding while their main herd sires are Hyalite Resource 331, a home raised son of KCF Bennett

early years. The Lott Ranch was our neighbor to the south and it was run by Bob, his folks and his two brothers. The Lott family had a long tradition in Twin Bridges as some of the early Lott ancestors started the town of Twin Bridges and gave it its name with the two toll bridges that they built over the Beaverhead and the Big Hole Rivers.

Lott family ancestors were very instrumental in the Gold Rush days of Virginia City, MT and were among the first Vigilantes that captured and hung the infamous Plummer Gang in the 1860s.

Being neighbors, Bob and I entered into a lot of kid activities in our younger days. Shortly after Bob graduated from high school, he joined the Army and was assigned to Camp Carson in Colorado, which at the time was a mountain training center, similar to the Army Rangers of today. They became experts in both mountain climbing and skiing.

As I was entering in my junior year in high school, I got the opportunity to work at the Dan Thornton Hereford Ranch in Gunnison, CO for one summer. At the time the Thornton Ranch was one of the premier Hereford operations in the world. I wrote Bob and told of my upcoming employment in Gunnison and he wrote me back and said that he had a big Indian motorcycle and that he would be happy to pick me up at the Denver Airport and take me over to Gunnison.

The plans were made and I got passage on an old war surplus Douglas C-47 from Butte, MT to Stapleton Field in Denver. They were operating under the guise of an airline, but the airplane and facilities were very crude by today's standards, but at that time and in those days, I didn't know the difference.

I was deplaned at Stapleton next to a freight shack and was left by myself in that area. After about three hours of waiting, I heard the sound of a motorcycle and up the ramp came Bob Lott on his big old Indian. After a few minutes of joyful greeting we boarded the motorcycle and since I was wearing a hat and had a suitcase, I had no choice but to balance on the back of the motorcycle while trying to hold on to my hat in one hand the suitcase in the other.

We roared through Denver and on to Colorado Springs at an expedited pace. I was amazed at the amount of cars we were going by and I was having quite a balancing act on the seat behind Bob. I finally did get a chance to peek around Bob at the speedometer and it was peaking at 120 miles per hour.

We made it to Colorado Springs in good order and took a rest while inspecting the grand Broadmore Ho-

tel, which today is still a spectacular hotel.

We then headed out toward Gunnison, but by the time we got to Cañon City we realized that we would not make it to Gunnison before dark, so we decided to stay in the Colorado penitentiary town.

Since we did not have a bunch of money and the hotels were full, we had to stay at a very questionable hotel that night and we worried about being broken into or having the Indian stolen, but we made it through the night with no trouble, and headed out to Gunnison up Monarch Pass the next morning.

For those of you who don't know Monarch Pass, it is a long mountain pass to the west that heads uphill to just under 10,000 feet high. About halfway up Monarch Pass, the old Indian "belched" a few times and gave up, and there we were half way to our destination without a function-

ing motorcycle and wondering who might stop and help us, and what would we do with the motorcycle.

After about an hour of traffic going by us, looking but not stopping, an old well used pickup pulled up and stopped. In the cab were two old people and in the back two of their kids were riding. The old Pilgrim said, "You two boys look like you could use some help" and we said, "We really, really do." The old man said he didn't know about fixing motorcycles but he was headed to Gunnison and would take us and the motorcycle, if we could get it in the truck.

Well, the old Indian weighed about 1,000 pounds and we knew we couldn't lift it into the truck, so we were wondering how we would handle the situation, the old Pilgrim suggested that there was an old unused sign about 50 yards back down the road and maybe we could salvage



enough lumber off of it to roll the motorcycle into the truck. We successfully salvaged enough timber to roll the Indian up into the truck and Bob and I, and the Indian, rode in the back of the truck with the kids at about a 30 mile an hour pace into Gunnison. Our savior knew of a shop that worked on motorcycles and he drove us straight there where we unloaded the Indian.

We said our thanks and farewells to the family that helped us in our hour of need. Bob was told by the mechanic that he could fix the Indian rapidly, so Bob planned to head back to camp as soon as he could. I called the Thornton Ranch and they were able to come pick me up in a short time. Bob and I said our good byes and went on our separate ways. It would be several years later that Bob and I would meet again. I had gone on through college and served in the Air Force and Bob had gone on to The Washington State University of Veterinary Medicine and had returned to his hometown of Twin Bridges, and immediately opened a practice. When I returned home from the Air Force, Bob was already working as our ranch Vet and had built a sizeable clientele in a short time as there were few large animal "Docs" in the area of 80 to 100 miles.

Besides our business connections, Bob and I were both very sports oriented and we competed on local independent teams in softball, baseball and basketball, and later as both of us had married and had families we coached both our boys and girls in baseball and softball for over 15 years. We even continued our softball activities in to

our golden years and were part of the last Championship Men's Softball team from the area to represent Twin Bridges.

Bob's son, Rob, who we had both coached, would later become one of Montana's Class C most winning coaches, during a career that spanned almost 25 years. Another former Little League player who Bob and I both coached was named Little League Coach of the Year in Wyoming in the early 2000s is Robert Nolte. Bob helped with our cattle at many fairs as the summer time was a slack period for him and he enjoyed fairs and the show cattle. Bob also became a pilot and flew with me on many trips in the cattle business. Dr. Lott served for 40 years on the Madison County Fair Board and was instrumental in organizing the sales group in FFA and 4-H to merchandise their products. A great sports fan, "Doc" attended and helped at many athletic functions during his lifetime.

The so called "golden years" are often not too golden, and about 10 years ago declining health forced Bob to give up his activities and his profession of 50 years. Approximately, five years ago Dr. Lott was required to move in to an assisted living center where he spent the remainder of his life.







He was preceded in death by his mother and his grandparents.

Survivors include his father, Ernest "Bing" Ashcraft, and his brother, Barry Ashcraft, both of Twin Bridges, and his niece, Judy and nephew, Troy.

## Robert Carson "Doc" Lott

Robert Carson "Doc" Lott was born September 25, 1925, to Mortimer John and Bess Dawes Lott on the family ranch in Twin Bridges. He graduated from Twin Bridges High School in 1943 and attended Colorado A&M in Fort Collins, CO, before enlisting in the Army in January 1946.

After serving as a member of the U.S. Army Mountain Ski Troops, Bob continued his education at Montana State University, where he was involved with the Bobcat basketball team and became friends with legendary coach Brick Breeden. He then followed his passion for animal science to Washington State University, where he earned both a Bachelor of Biological Science and a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree.

"Doc," as he was known throughout southwest Montana, treated animals of all shapes and sizes as owner and operator of the Twin Bridges Veterinary Hospital, from 1954 to 2005. He was a familiar sight traveling throughout the area in his specially equipped vet truck to treat livestock. Bob was an incredibly hard worker and dedicated his life to serving all the people and animals of an expansive region. He even earned his pilot's license and flew to far away ranches to treat animals or airdrop medicine.

Bob was a pillar in the Twin Bridges community throughout his life. He was a member of the Madison County Fair Board for over 40 years and gave

Bob earned his Scuba Diving Certification, which he used to assist in water missions in local lakes and rivers as a member of Madison County Search & Rescue. He was also a longtime member of the Twin Bridges Volunteer Fire Department.

Despite dedicating long hours to his practice and numerous civic duties, Doc was a man of many hobbies. A passion for the outdoors led to countless hiking, hunting, and fishing adventures in the mountains throughout the Ruby Valley, which he knew like the back of his hand. He studied the geology of the area and was skilled in fly-tying and woodworking. He was a fervent reader and lifelong learner.

Bob was well known as an avid sports fan and a loyal supporter of the Twin Bridges Falcons. He volunteered his time to run the scoreboard at TBHS football and basketball games for over 20 years and missed very few games throughout his life. He was a great athlete himself, participating in everything from basketball and baseball to bowling and horseshoes. Doc was proud to play competitive softball well into his 70s and coached many teams through the years.

As a loving father and grandfather, true friend and icon in the community, Bob left a lasting impression on all who knew him. We will always remember the lessons he taught us, his sly smile, and his quick wit.

Bob took his trip to heaven on August 26, 2016. He is survived by: his children, Rob Lott, Dan Lott, Holly Haithcox (Bruce Pericich) and Thomas Lott; daughter-in-law Kathy Lott; grandchildren Whitney, Kelcy and Tyler Lott, Trisha Lott, Amanda and Jared Haithcox, and Bailey and Emily Lott; great-grandson Gus; and countless friends. He was preceded in death by his parents and brothers.

## Herefords Make the Grade at Gfellers

The Gfeller herd was started in the 1950s by Dick Gfeller. The first cows were purchased from the Beck Brothers of Parkerville. At the time there were 18 heifers bought. These were the only cows the Gfellers have purchased during the ranch's existence.

Currently they run about 100 head of registered cows, half spring calvers and half fall calvers, along with 200 commercial spring calving cows. Dick's son Richard and his wife Debby are now on the ranch as well.

During the last 26 years the Gfellers have purchased 6 outside bulls, mostly of Ridder breeding going back to some Canadian bloodlines.

Calves are weaned in October or November with steers and heifers run together. They run on grass until August or September when they are brought home to their feedlot. They are all enrolled in the Hereford Verified program. Each one is weighed, implanted and tagged with an electronic tag.

The fall calves are run by Dick for 8-9 months, weaned then put on brome until November when they are put in the feedlot. They are sold in April or May.

On average the calves are fed 150-165 days. When they are ready they go to National Beef in Dodge City, KS.

In the feedlot they are fed whole corn, corn gluten, a protein supplement and free choice sudan hay. Following is the cost breakdown:

Cattle on feed for 165 days being fed 68 bushels of whole corn at \$3.30/bushel for a total of \$224,

corn gluten \$33 and protein supplement \$34. Sudan hay was \$30 so total cost per head was \$321. That year the heifers and steers both were worth \$1348. Their pay weight was 1355 lbs. and they brought an average of \$1.38/lb. So they brought \$1875 a head with a \$206 profit over feed cost (172 head), according to Richard.

Being in the Hereford Verified program Gfellers get data back on each calf. following are several comparisons. Also, they have had a very consistent average daily gain of 3.5 for heifers and 4 lbs./day for steers. And this is for the past 17 years!

Here is the impressive part, how they graded:

1999 — 33% Choice  
2008 — 54% Choice  
2015 Fall Calves — 100% Choice with some Prime  
2016 — 90% Choice with some Prime  
Fall calves 90% Choice

1999 — 33% YG 1s and 2s  
2008 — 38% 1s and 2s  
2016 — 60% 1s and 2s

Ribeye Area  
1999 — No data available  
2008 — 12 in.  
2016 — 13.8 in. (heifers & steers)

Richard Gfeller concluded his comments saying, "All the credit goes back to these bulls we've purchased the last 26 years. These two bulls here on display (R 157 K Northstar 10T and R 521 T Northstar 16X) are keeping right up with the carcass data plus they've improved the udders on the cows."



nett Revolution X51.

Zero Ranch, owned by the Smedra family, had bulls and pairs on display at Lintons. Their ranch started in 1920 by William P. Winter, Sr., and is now in its fifth generation. Mostly a commercial cowherd, the Smedras breeding is predominantly Line One. They run about 700 head.

Next stop on the tour was Kucera's Beaver Creek Ranch at Litchfield, NE. Headed by Frank, Luke and Carl Kucera, this family has been raising Herefords for the past 50 years. Their program is primarily Polled Hereford genetics with an occasional horned line used for out-cross. The focus at Kucera's is performance and functionality. The Kucera's had a fabulous lunch prepared for a large crowd and then it was back to the headquarters hotel in Broken Bow to listen to Trey Befort give a presentation on Certified Hereford Beef.

Trey is the Director of Commercial Programs. He discussed the continued progress of the CHB program from producer to packer. The two packing plants which CHB currently uses are National Beef and Greater Omaha. Several new Nebraska distributors have come on board making CHB more available at retail locations in Nebraska. They have

also launched a new website

The program currently has outlets in 40 states and Panama.

Befort said the CHB program has a bright future. Quality and consistency of the product is excellent and with added staff and value-added opportunities the program is expected to grow.

After being educated about CHB, the group went just outside of town to Cain Land & Livestock. On the tour van I was on, Maureen Cain gave us a running commentary about their land, vet clinic, history and programs on the way out to their cattle display just a few miles out

of town. We were greeted by the family which included Dr. Don Cain, DVM, his wife Maureen, children Jentry, Nathan and Heather plus Don's parents Mary Lou and Don Sr.

Along with their cattle herds which consist of Herefords, Red Angus and Black Baldies, the Cains own and operate Central Nebraska Veterinary Service. Don is a veterinarian, Maureen is an RN who assists in veterinary surgeries and inventory management and Jentry is the hospital coordinator. Their Hereford herd started in 1925 and their Red Angus herd was established in 1985. They have both spring and fall calving programs and emphasize moderate framed cattle with low birth weight, calving ease, cow efficiency and feedlot performance. They have retained ownership on feedlot cattle since 1997 and utilized grid marketing.

The next tour stop was a short distance away to Richard and Cindi-Lou Estergard's near Callaway, NE. Their herd of registered Herefords started in the 1970s from the base of 4-H heifers. The first registered cattle came from Paul and John Ridder. Richard's parents and grandparents were commercial Hereford producers. The current Estergard cowherd is Line One based. They also raise a few registered Quarter Horses.

To end the first day, the large tour

group gathered at Ridder Herefords near Callaway, Nebraska. We were greeted by John and Mary Ridder and family. The Ridders need no introduction, having been in business since 1907 when John's grandparents Theodore and Elizabeth moved to the Callaway area from north-eastern Nebraska. Their base at that time was from Mousel Bros. genetics. John's dad Paul took over the ranch after WWII with John by his side and eventually succeeding him. They have shown carloads at the National Western Stock Show since the 1970s and continue their focus on functional, maternal, growthy cattle that will perform for both commercial and seedstock producers. Ridders had several large, impressive pens of pairs and heifers on display plus a few herd bulls.

A fabulous CHB and Hereford steak supper was served while the group was entertained by a great dance band. A very enjoyable evening was had by all.

The second day of the tour had a different focus and was centered around a judging contest for both juniors and adults. A breakfast first thing in the morning was hosted by TK Cattle Co., Kaci, Trevor and Khloe Toelle at Burwell. They are a young couple who got their start shortly after getting married in 2012. Their focus is on producing top quality females with eye appeal and the ability to show well.

Kaci's family the John & Joni Nelson's also had a nice display of breeding cattle. Their children Justin and Sarah, Brett and Erin and Brody are all involved in the farm and cattle as well.

A delicious breakfast was served to 180 people as we all hung onto our hats. The previous day had perfect weather for a tour but this day started out cool and windy but leveled out at the second stop. Again, another large crowd here with some 70 juniors in attendance.

The judging contest was started at TK Cattle Co. and continued at the next stop which was the rodeo grounds. Displays by 5 or 6 breeders also became judging classes. At stake to the high point junior winner was a beautiful registered heifer
