It's hard to believe we are to the end of the bull sale season and the end of our publishing season. We'll return in August

with the September issue.

Our run of bull sales is always different, from year to year and sale to sale. There is an incredible number of moving parts that go into marketing registered cattle from the breeder perspective and all the people involved who help and onto the buyer's side.

# Journagan Ranch/Missouri State: Where Agriculture Meets the Pavement

By B. Lynn Gordon Leo Journagan was a visionary businessman who built a legacy in both construction and cattle, gaining a new perspective of being a steward of the land from each business entity. He pieced together 3,300-acres in south central Missouri, over a 45-year period, consisting of native grassland, pastures, cropland, creeks, ponds, and natural wooded species. Grazing on these picturesque Ozark hills is the 15th largest Hereford herd in the nation - which became well-known as the Leo Journagan Ranch (LJR), Mountain Grove,

In 2010, four years before his passing, Journagan presented a momentous gift to Missouri State University (MSU), Springfield, MO, donating the entire LJR ranch complete with land, equipment, facilities and more than 1,000 head of cattle. Recorded as the second largest single gift in the history of the 104-year old institution, this more than 7-million-dollar gift created an innovative, outdoor classroom advancing educational opportunities at MSU's William H. Darr College of Agriculture to heights never imagined.

Journagan's donation ensured the ranch remained as a working ranch, as complete one unit, and would create a unique, hands-on experience for future generations of agriculture students. The positive experiences and values he cherished from raising top-quality

Hereford cattle in a holistic environment would now build a connection between his ranch, MSU's Springfield campus, 60 miles away and the nearby Mountain Grove campus. You could say, it was Leo Journagan's way of having agriculture meet the pavement.

### Impact will live on

Journagan purchased his first Hereford heifers while serving in World War II. After the war, he rented property until the mid-60s when he bought his first piece of land. In 1975, he went on to purchase his first registered Polled Herefords and in 1981 hired Marty Lueck, a pre-veterinary graduate of Southwest Missouri State University (later renamed MSU) to serve as manager. Marty shared Leo's passion for raising quality seedstock and together they took the ranch beyond what even

they ever dreamed it could be. Lueck, is well-established and well-respected in the purebred cattle circles, not just in Missouri but internationally, leading the genetic program at LJR since its inception, including overseeing 26 production sales and selling genetics to 40 states, Canada, Mexico, Kazakhstan, and several other international countries. Today the Leo Journagan Ranch of Missouri State University consists of 450 cows, 150 heifers, (split across spring and fall calving) along with a closed herd of 160 commercial females. Eighty to 90 bulls are sold private treaty, annually, a number that may be unmatched in the Hereford breed.

Uniquely, the generous donation by the Journagan family also included people. Lueck continues to serve as ranch manager, and four ranch employees remain employed, all now considered MSU staff. "Leo said he was going to provide for us (employees), and with this donation he did, he took care of us, just as he promised," Lueck says.

### **Student success**

Now MSU students have the rare opportunity to interact with the largest Hereford herd associated with a Univer-

sity in the U.S. "Some students apply to be interns throughout the summer, and other students experience the ranch on classroom visits, working on research or special projects," Lueck says. Summer interns work in synchronization with the day-to-day ranching operations to provide for the most real-life experience. "For many students, this is an eye-opening experience, they have never worked on a ranch of this size or a seedstock operation with responsibilities of this scale." Students learn about and assist with duties such as calving, breeding, treating, and feeding cattle to building fence. "My role is to teach them about the things you can't learn in a textbook but need to know about managing beef cattle-the ranch is one great big lab not encrusted within walls.'

Gaining first-hand ranch experience is now an integral part of education at MSU impacting students with or without an agricultural background. Plus, the living and breathing diverse laboratory has allowed University research, teaching and Extension to study topics in areas from animal science to biology, forestry, geology, genetics, plant science, soil quality, wildlife management and viticulture. The appeal of gaining a real-life perspective is believed to have resulted in a 10% increase of agricultural student enrollment annually since the donation. Overall enrollment at MSU's college of agriculture has grown from 300 to 800 students in the last ten years.

Justin Sissel, manages MSU's livestock properties near the Springfield campus and serves as an instructor for the cattle sale preparation class. Students exhibit LJR cattle at four shows annually in Missouri and those who excel in achieving the class requirements, are selected to represent LJR/MSU at the

National Western Stock Show (NWSS), reach many new customers. As part of Denver. CO. With cattle in tow, and a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity of caring, showing and marketing seedstock, at this premier livestock event, the students have made the ranch and University proud. LJR/MSU has exhibited the division championship pen of three heifers from 2016-2018.

"The students have added a new marketing twist to the ranch," Lueck says. A ranch facebook page complete with daily updates and videos from events such as the NWSS is one example. "They will post a video and it will have 2,000 hits, it's amazing and allowed our genetics to

"The addition of LJR has made a profound impact on our students," Sissel says. "For students to have an efficient, working cattle ranch to walk onto at any given moment and to perform the practical aspect of what they are learning in the classroom is immense. And to have a ranch manager like Marty, and a knowledgeable staff, can only



undoubtedly give our students a leg up in this competitive world as they make an impact on society with their careers," emphasizes Sissel.

Both Lueck and Sissel remind students, college is what you make of it, and how this generous gift has created endless opportunities unique to the students at MSU to further their education.

### The beef business

The educational focus extends beyond the production side of the industry - teaching about the beef value chain from gate to plate. MSU Beef, was developed to highlight the farm to table movement in the food industry.

The MSU Beef Program starts with 10 to 20 Journagan Ranch steers sorted off from each of the calving seasons (Spring and Fall). After weaning and 60-day pre-conditioning, the calves are moved to Springfield, placed on grass and supplemented with limited grain. Two or three steers are processed monthly, while others remain on feed. A rotation occurs to accommodate a steer removed from the finish pasture, with a steer moved into the backgrounding group. The steers are on a finishing ration for 90-days and harvested at a local USDA inspected plant during an individual lot harvest, to allow for traceability. From the processing plant, the product is delivered to the campus meat lab, and an additional random sample from each lot is collected and sent for further food safety testing.

All meat is dry aged for two weeks, then frozen, with steaks individually packaged and ground beef in clear onepound cubes. Roasts average 2-3 lbs. Pre-made hamburger patties and beef

bratwurst are examples of value-added products sold. Additional specialty cuts are available by special-order. Wholesale clients email their orders to MSU and product is delivered within 24 hours. MSU Beef is currently sold in three Springfield stores, Hy-Vee a Midwest grocery chain, and two farmers market stores associated with the processing plant. Students are involved in all aspects of MSU Beef from feeding, delivering the product and promotion.

### **Maternal Methods**

Nominated for Beef Improvement Federation's, 2016 Seedstock Producer of the Year. LJR remains a foremost Hereford seedstock herd. "The mother cow is the true anchor in our program,' Lueck says. He developed an udder scoring system 35-years ago, and now the ranch has shifted to the guidelines recently developed by the American Hereford Association (AHA). To guarantee the best maternal source, the ranch tracks calving ease, birth weight, ratios, foot, and leg structure is analyzed, progeny weaning ratios are evaluated, and cow weights are collected at weaning time to measure maternal efficiency.

With detailed record-keeping, and

that LJR has been recognized for 20 Dams of Distinction by the AHA for 15 of the last 20 years. "Dams of Distinction identifies the most efficient and productive females, and that's our top priority," says Lueck.

"Our selec-

tion criteria is simple," he adds, "it's economic driven." Every decision on the ranch is focused on keeping the ranch sustainable and profitable, a great lesson for the next generation.

Because of this wonderful asset awarded to MSU, the successful legacy



the first day of Spring, I've heard there was some snow that moved through Kansas at least, but they've already been battling wildfires in the southern states.

I suppose I should mention the EPD formula change once again. Launched right ahead of the bull sale season, great timing, producers were left wondering what the new system meant and how it would affect them. Many commercial people in the area I travel, either didn't realize what had happened or just didn't use them or now don't use them, just use actual weights. I suppose the jury is still out on this one as breeders try to make sense of everything, learn the new system and use the numbers they are getting every week.

In the meantime, we all continue with our great breed of Hereford cattle. They don't know the EPDs changed. Those of us involved in raising Herefords will continue to strive for improvement, one way or another.

I want to congratulate my dad and our family on achieving 100-year status for our ranch. By the way, he gets a pass this month on writing.

In 1918 my grandparents, Art and Elizabeth Bayers started their Hereford

herd in Lavina, MT.

My grandfather had been born and raised on a farm in Iowa, the child of Danish immigrants. They farmed and raised cattle but it turns out Grandpa was a great baseball player and ended up playing college and semi-pro (for the time) baseball in Iowa in the late 1800s, early 1900s. I'm unsure of the story in-between, I think it involved traveling through North Dakota and doing a variety of jobs, but he eventually was hired at the bank in Lavina which was just starting up in 1910. The the condition was he play baseball for them. So in 1910 or 1911 he headed to Lavina for his first adult job and big adventures in Montana.

Meanwhile, my grandmother Elizabeth Dwyer, who was born and raised in Illinois, decided to head West at the age of 17 or 18. For reasons unknown other than the promise of free land and transportation on the new railroad system, she and her sister Josephine homesteaded north of Lavina, MT. Later, another sister, Stella, and their father William Dwyer also homesteaded in the same area. William was the son of Irish immigrants. The family farmed and raised cattle and horses in the Henry, IL area and also lived in Momence, IL.

Unfortunately I never heard more than one story from my grandmother about the homestead days other than she and her sister used to milk cows for the neighbors in order to make money. I'm sure life wasn't easy in those homestead days and they worked hard for their land. Grandma also worked in the hotel in Lavina.

Meanwhile Art was working in the brand new bank, playing baseball and also filed on a homestead. He was also the Land Man at the bank and administered accounts for people filing on homesteads.

Art and Elizabeth married on Christmas Day, 1912, and ranched near Lavina. They had a few Shorthorns and Herefords and horses in the early days. In 1918 they started their registered Hereford herd and never looked back. They had 6 children including my dad: Helen, Beatrice, Bertha, Jeanne, Wanda and Byron.

They homesteaded there and over the course of some 10 or 15 years in the Lavina area were involved in several businesses including the local bank and selling cars but both of them had roots in agriculture and ended up loving Hereford cattle.

It's been fun looking through old photos, connecting with my cousins,

talking to dad about it and looking at old Hereford record books and stories.

It's a lovely, rich history carried forward by dad and other family members who shared that devotion to Herefords and ranching. Thanks for the wonderful legacy.



# Final Farewell

### **Humberto "Bert" Reyes**

Texas cattleman, auctioneer, and father, died on February 13, 2018 at age 89. Bert was the middle of 14 children born to Carlos Reyes B. of Durango, Mexico and Maria Villarreal of Goliad, TX. He was raised on a farm outside Berclair, TX. He attended a two-room, segregated Mexican-only school until he went to Goliad High School, where he graduated in 1946. Bert raised Hereford calves since he was 9 and was chosen as one of 14 outstanding 4H members in Mexico and Texas. With his brother Carlos, who returned from serving in WWII, he enrolled at Texas A&M, where his grades, 4H work, and support from his community earned him one of the first Jesse Jones opportunity scholarships. At A&M, Bert followed in the footsteps of his older brothers and found a home in the animal science department. He was a member of the A&M livestock and meat-judging teams and was awarded the showman-of-the-year prize as a se-

Bert joined the Army upon graduation, and served as a first lieutenant in the infantry during the Korean war, distinguishing himself during the horrific fighting at Heartbreak Ridge. He was awarded a combat infantry badge, 3 bronze service stars, and a UN service medal. After Korea, Bert returned to A&M, where he earned a Master's Degree in Animal Science. Upon graduation, A&M asked him to join a team of professors and technicians to work on a two-year project in a sister school in Saltillo, Mexico. As the only Spanish speaker of the group, Bert learned a lot outside of his discipline and developed relationships with ranchers throughout Northern Mexico. When he returned to Texas, Bert was hired by the Hereford Association as a special representative to move cattle from drought-stricken areas of Texas into Mexico. That work allowed him to travel throughout Texas and Mexico, meeting more ranchers and learning about their herds and needs. By 1958, Bert had opened his own business, Carlos B. and Sons, with the help of his father, then a bookkeeper in Beeville. At first, Bert specialized in exporting cattle, private treaty, and sales management. But after a week of auctioneering school and hundreds of hours of practice while driving the Texas highways, Bert became one of America's most prominent cattle auctioneers and changed the business in Texas. Bert became the first sales manager-auctioneer, a job that had customarily been done by two people. He also refused to specialize in any particular breed of cattle, as most did at the time. Bert innovated cattle auctions by moving sales from weekdays to weekends, in order to allow urban cattle investors to attend and drive up sale prices. As the only Spanish bilingual auctioneer

in North America, he pulled new clients into Texas sales.

Bert moved his business to San Antonio and lived at the St. Anthony Hotel for a decade before he married Jane Maverick Welsh. In the mid-sixties, his younger brother Ruben began working for him and they eventually partnered in creating Reyes and Reyes. During his career, Bert build the country's largest cattle-auctioneering firm selling more than \$30 million in pure blooded cattle annually. He called many historic auctions, breaking national sales records for many breeds including Beefmaster, Simmental, and Brangus. He broke million-dollar-sales records at the National Simmental Sale in 1974 and twomillion-dollar national sales record for all breeds in 1979 at the Herring Ranch Beefmaster dispersal sale. Bert also negotiated the importation of the first pure blooded Simmental bull, Amor, into the United States. He and six other investors worked for two years to purchase Amor in 1970. Bert sold cattle in 28 states and in many parts of Latin America. He was honored to have been consulted by President Johnson while he alive and was asked by Lady Bird to manage dispersal sale of LBJ's cattle upon the former president's death.

Bert never needed a hobby. He loved his work and the cattle business -- it pleases us to know he attended the SA stock show on the day he died. Bert was the oldest tenant and last remaining cattleman at the San Antonio Stock Yards building. He was a teller of tales, able to remember first hand longhorn cattle drives through the streets of Berclair during the 1930s and the heyday of San Antonio's cattle business. For the past year, Bert has been working with the Texas A&M San Antonio Library archiving his cattle-business records, logging thousands of photographs, and providing an oral history for researchers.

While proud of his own accomplishments, Bert realized they were built upon his parents' love and their investment in his education and the education of his siblings. He was incredibly proud of the accomplishments of his six sisters, all teachers in the public school system, and his seven brothers who entered the business community. He honored the sacrifice of his mother and the work his father did to integrate schools in their community. Bert is survived by his daughter Carmelita Reyes; son-in-law Jeffrey Johns; grandsons Carlos and Mateo Johns; sister Estella Naranjo; brother Mike Reyes (Elida), brother-in-law Dr. Victor Rodriguez; and loving companion for many years Sharon Buchta. He was preceded in death by his parents Carlos and Maria Reves; sisters Rachel, Tillie, Christina, Florinda, and Martha; brothers Lucas, Alvino, Tony, Carlos Jr., Pete, and Ruben; ex-wife Jane Maverick Welsh; and dear friend Mary Annah Hoey-Alemán.
