



continues and as one surviving couple recently told me, "The story has moved past the blizzard. It's no longer about the loss, it's about what we've been given." In the months since the October blizzard I have staved in touched with Riley and Jimmie Kammerer who were hit hard by the storm. I've spoken with and e-mailed Jimmie through the months, mostly checking on how they were doing. Their name came to me through mutual friends the Reinholds at Rainbow Bible Ranch/Lonetree Ranch who were also devastated by the storm. After a recent heifer donation delivery which left the Kammerers speechless and in awe of the generosity, Jimmie told me, "it's no longer about the loss, it's about what we've been given. That's the story now...the life, the hope, the job. I hope the nation takes note.

The Kammerers have received several donations of cattle. Like others in the area, such outpourings of generosity are, at first, hard to accept. But they along with others are learning some wonderful lessons about life, faith, people and God.

Since the October storm which decimated livestock in western South Dakota over \$3 million have been raised to help ranch families who sustained large losses of cattle, sheep, horses and buffalo. Heifers for South Dakota continues to take in live donations or purchase cattle with monetary donations, and has made several greatly appreciated deliveries of heifers to ranchers in need. And private donations continue to be made as well. These rarely make the news but are making the difference in the lives of many.

Such a story of devastation to begin with has turned into a brilliant story of life, generosity of ranch families who realize the plight of those affected and are in a position to help and the gratitude of those receiving the gifts of livestock and monetary assistance not from the government but from many across the nation and the world who have been moved to give.

One gentleman who would have loved this story is Marc's Uncle Dub who recently passed away. He ranched in the affected area and although their family's losses weren't as high as others, I'm sure he would have helped out in any way he could. What a wonderful man he was. Big, rangey cowboy who was truly a gentle man with strong faith, a big heart and a love for God and life. He grew up in New Mexico during the Depression, served in World War II and returned home to ranch, moving several times during his life. He'd had some Hereford cattle during his lifetime and when we visited, Dub always had a few questions about Herefords and the cattle market. Even in his days at the nursing home he kept up with livestock news and had a good idea what was going on but truly missed his life on the ranch near Mud Butte, SD.

He was a special man and will be missed.





Herefords from Montana donated to South Dakota Couple Hit by Storm

The day after Christmas there was a trailer load of bred heifers that left Montana to be donated to a young ranch couple. I remember from his short speech was that they had found that cattle with more dewlap fat had come through the winter better than other cows. At that time they had a winter pasture between Crow Agency and Busby, MT. They did not feed hay but depended on the wind to blow snow off of the hills and ridges. I assume they did feed hay to other bunches of cows that had in other places. The snow was just too deep and not enough wind to bare off surfaces.

If Herefords came through Storm Atlas in better shape than others, I would assume that thinking people would make a switch back to Herefords. Better a live calf the wrong color than a dead calf.

The Leddys have been farming and raising cattle on the same ground near Twin Brooks, SD, for over 100 years. Some of the current operation was purchased by Gene's great-grandmother in 1883. In 1910 Gene's grandfather purchased the place Gene is on today and started building barns and corrals there.

Gene's father Ralph started with Herefords in the early 1930s and Herefords have been grazing the pastures on their place southeast of Twin Brooks ever since.

Today, Gene along with Wade and Lori and their daughters Rebecca and Allison, operate Leddy's Hereford and Red Angus. The operation consists of 100 Hereford and 100 Red Angus cows which are all registered. The Red Angus were added in the early 1990s. In addition to cattle they also raise corn and alfalfa. This is a family operation and Wade and Lori's daughters are the sixth generation to work on the farm. Gene stated that every cow and heifer is Aled and that everyone in the family is around to help during that time.

The Hereford cowherd consists of Boomer, Revolution and Ribeye breeding. Bulls are marketed through their annual bull sale as well as the Watertown Winter Farm Show. Leddys have been exhibiting at that show since the late 1950s. In 2011 the show was dedicated to Gene Leddy for his years of support of the show. Gene still remains on the Hereford show committee. The Leddys have also sold at the South Dakota Excellence Sale since its beginning and have marketed a number of competitive show heifers and sale toppers. The Leddy family has also been a long time supporter of the Sioux Empire Farm Show and Black Hills Stock Show.

They have hosted numerous South Dakota Hereford Tours and Junior Field Days over the years as well. Gene has been an exhibitor at the South Dakota State Fair since 1939. The only one he has missed since then was in 1952!

As long time supporters of 4-H, the Leddy family has hosted judging schools since the 1940s. Some of the current 4-H members are the third generation to judge on their place.

They recently hosted an Accelerated Genetics tour where 45 managers from around the country, including 15 states, viewed the Leddy calves which are in large part from their AI program.
