that had been in the breed, in the past, did not affect his decisions, so the hiring of a new person was a critical decision.

Hop, at that time was part of the AHA staff that included about six people, who were all very good in their various areas of the AHA. Hop formally applied for the position, however, several members of the board were aware that other members of the staff would be interested in the position. The board worked all day trying to make the hiring decision, and without one being made in the daytime, we decided to stay as long as it took that night to make the final decision. Hop was hired after several of the board members who originally had objections, changed their mind, after we finally worked out the details of the objections, at about three o'clock in the morning Hop was made Executive Vice President of the American Hereford Association.

I was coming in as President the following year and we had several things ahead of us that we would be working on hard. In those days we met as a board for three full days, not quite the same as now. One project was that we knew that the Hereford breed had to be carried forward as one breed. At that time there was the American Polled Hereford Association and the American Hereford Association.

It was our board's firm feeling that the two groups should be joined. Hop and I, as well as the other board members, were to talk to the polled breeders to get their opinions on a possibility of a merger. Hop spent much time talking to the then CEO of the Polled Hereford Association and I talked to a lot of the polled breeders and also spent much time with the chairman of the polled group. Most people that raised Herefords agreed that we were better off with one organization, making one stance, for the Hereford industry, rather than having two groups competing with each other, on a national level.

The year was 1976 and I was very optimistic, as I am sure the rest of the board had similar feelings that we would get the merger done, and within a year or two we could be one united breed. (Are we there yet?) We agreed to have more meetings at the upcoming World Hereford Conference which was to be held later that year. This was another issue that faced our board, preparing for our delegation to go the World Hereford Conference, which was to be held in Canada at the Banff Springs Hotel.

As the AHA President I had the honor of being the co-delegate from the US, along with Don Norgren of Colorado. About two weeks before our delegation was to leave for Calgary, which is the nearest commercial airport to Banff, Hop called me and told me that we had a big problem! Hop told me our delegation had reserva-

tions to leave, and many of the wives were ready to accompany their husbands too, but the problem was a major airline strike in Canada and with the union involvement we were unable to get everybody beyond Great Falls, Montana. Hop continued on to say that now the time is so short I don't know what to do, and he wondered if I had any suggestions. Hop knew that I had a twin engine airplane and had flown a lot of the board members and the AHA officials around the US at various times, and he wondered if it was a possibility for me to facilitate a private airlift from Great Falls to Calgary. I told

him that I would get back to him within a day, and I would see if I could put together the airlift. I went to some of my friends in the aviation charter business in Montana and found three pilots and airplanes that would facilitate the transportation. I then called Hop and told him that I had 3 planes hired and with mine available, we would be able to transport all the people in one flight on the day preceding the World Hereford Conference. We assembled at Great Falls with flights coming in from Texas, Kansas City, Denver and Billings. Then on a beautiful afternoon day the squadron took off from Great Falls

and landed in Calgary between an hour and two hours later.

We then rented cars to our final destination of the Banff Springs Hotel. The World Hereford conference opening ceremony was one of the most memorable events in my Hereford life. It was much like the Olympic entry, only on a much smaller scale. I was one of the leaders in the US delegation that followed our American flag into the convention hall, in line with the other member nations. The Canadians did themselves proud with that conference, and I'm sure they did

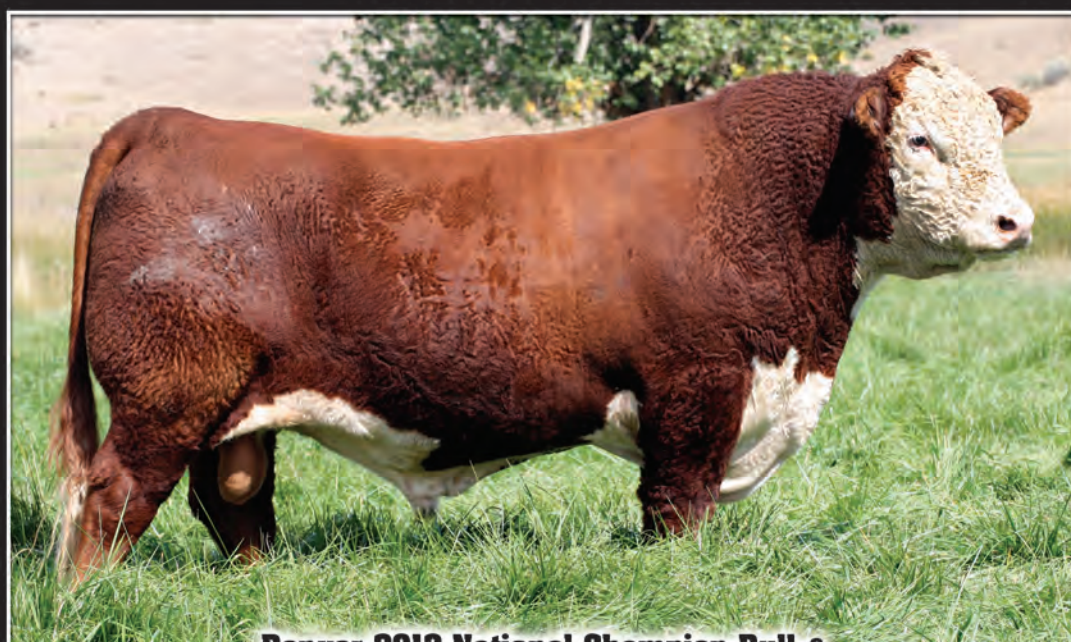

themselves as proud, in the last conference. We continued our talks with the people from the polled association, and its elected leader, at Banff, and things continued to be very hopeful that the merger would still be accomplished. As the conference was winding down our group went to visit the Bar Pipe Ranch, and the American delegation thought it would be very fitting if we could sing the Star Spangled Banner, as an American group at Bar Pipe, as it was the bicentennial celebration for our country. We asked Jim Cross, then owner of the Bar Pipe, (who is father of Donald Cross and the grandfather of Jay Cross, who is the current owner of

Bar Pipe and one of the leaders of the 2013 World Conference). Jim said you are very welcome to sing your national anthem, and our Canadian group will sing our anthem as well. I felt sorry for the people of the other countries as they did not have very many people to have much of a song group. Even though Hop didn't profess to be a song leader our group felt he should lead us in the in the singing of our anthem, which he reluctantly agreed to do. When all of us Yanks got ready to sing our national anthem, Hop started off with the words of "America the Beautiful", and of course, that brought laughter from everyone, and Hop was good naturedly embarrassed by the er-

ror, and everyone gave him a bad time, but then we settled down, started over, and in tribute to our great country, we sang the "Star Spangled Banner." Some of the real fun side of Hop also came out, when our US group got together and had a few embellishments in one of our rooms, the night before the conference started, Hop and Polly Dickenson, Don and Donna Norgren, Lee and Francis Campbell and Pauline and I, and others from the US, enjoyed a wonderful and hilarious evening together, which made the business of the World Hereford Conference go away for a little while.

By the time the conference was over the airline strike subsided and every-

one was able to go home on their original airline reservations. Pauline and I flew home in the 310 without the group that we had ferried north, and the plane seemed somewhat empty. As time progressed in 1976, we thought the merger was going well, when we got word that a very influential, long time polled breeder in the south, had marshalled his troops, and his friends, and breeders he had worked with, and had called the impending merger ridiculous. That stopped the movement for a time, even though the ground was laid for a merger, I felt for the good of the breed, it needed to be done, but it

would be several more years before the merger came to fruition.

We had at the time, when I was on the board of directors, and later as president, the most outstanding carcass program among the breeds. Our animals were fed out under AHA supervision and then slaughtered and then graded under the same supervision.

At that time our herd was third on the registration list of the AHA and we were running about 800 registered cows. I had personally felt like each of our herd bulls needed to be a Certified Carcass Sire and we had put together

seven Certified Carcass Sires from either the AHA or the Performance Registry International. One of our Certified Carcass Sires had also been a Denver Champion. Even though the program was expensive, because we put the steers in a feedlot, and butchered at a nearby facility where they were soon graded, we felt like this was the thing the breed needed to do. We had several people in the industry that had some cattle do extremely well in the show ring, including one Denver champion that had failed miserably, in the actual carcass evaluations. The pressure was really being put on the board, and on

Hop and the staff, not to release that data publicly. It was my opinion and several others on the board at that time, that any official program data supported by the AHA, should be available to all of our members, but the board voted, by a narrow margin, and with Hop's approval, not to release the data publicly, it could only be released by the owners of the animal. This was a real setback to me, and I thought, to our breed, but there was little more I could do about it at the time. At the end of 1976, my term both as a board member, and as president, had expired and as most of you ex-board members

know when you go off the board you really don't hear much about what is going on in Kansas City, any more, unless you have inside connections!

About two years later, a friend of mine, who was still on the staff of the AHA called me to tell me that "Hop and the board have decided that we will drop the carcass program, so I guess everything will be shut down as far the carcass program is concerned at the end of this year." As a Hereford breeder and as firm that had been in business at the time for over 50 years, I felt this was a real personal, and breed, disaster.

I knew at the time that this was a terrible mistake. At the time I left the AHA board we were the number one beef breed in the world and we had about 5 million dollars in reserve, in the bank, so we were in very good shape financially. When the American Angus Association realized what the Hereford Association had done, they really saw their opening and took it. They geared up all of their data and built in a new program which has become the byword of beef, internationally. Even though we knew that we still had the best product, we were totally out promoted in that 25 year period since our carcass program was dropped.

In the same period, our financial reserves went to disastrously low levels. Even though, Hop and I were friends, and thought we worked well together, I can never believe this was the proper decision, for he or the board, at that time.

In the article as written by Huffhines, we are starting to regroup and the programs we have now have seem to working well and today we are starting to regain some of the old glory days where the Hereford is again becoming popular within the beef circle. It is always hard to slip from Number 1 to Number 2 and we have to be very diligent watching the breeds that are third, fourth and fifth, because in the words of one of these associations, they think they will be second soon.

As a breed, we obviously have regrouped and are our statistics are climbing again in our acceptance level, with our major competitor, and in the term of cross bred, we are very viable.

We are basically now working with totally different technologies that we had in the '70s and we are working with a high percentage of people, who were probably in grade school at that time.

The educational levels have changed and that has brought knowledge of the technologies that our industry thrives on today. I just thought I would tell you some of the "rest of the story," hope you find these facts interesting.

It was interesting to read about the Schlickau family celebrating their 100th year in the Hereford business. An operation that originally home-steaded in 1872. I served on the AHA board with George Schlickau, who

Over the years, Conard and Nancy have been involved in the Hereford industry through various leadership roles. Conard served as president of the Buckeye Hereford Association (BHA).

The BHA gave its wholehearted recommendation of the Stitzleins for

this Hall of Fame induction. "Conard has been and continues to be a strong, positive influence on the Hereford industry," Scott Pennell, BHA president writes. "The quality Hereford genetics that he has provided this region as well as the world have shown to help Hereford cattle regain the market share of the beef industry."

Moreover, the Stitzleins have always been huge supporters of Hereford programs. Pennell adds, "They have consigned cattle to our state sale, regional feeder calf auctions as well as hosting their own events. Conard and Nancy are great supporters of our youth and the Hereford cattle they raise."

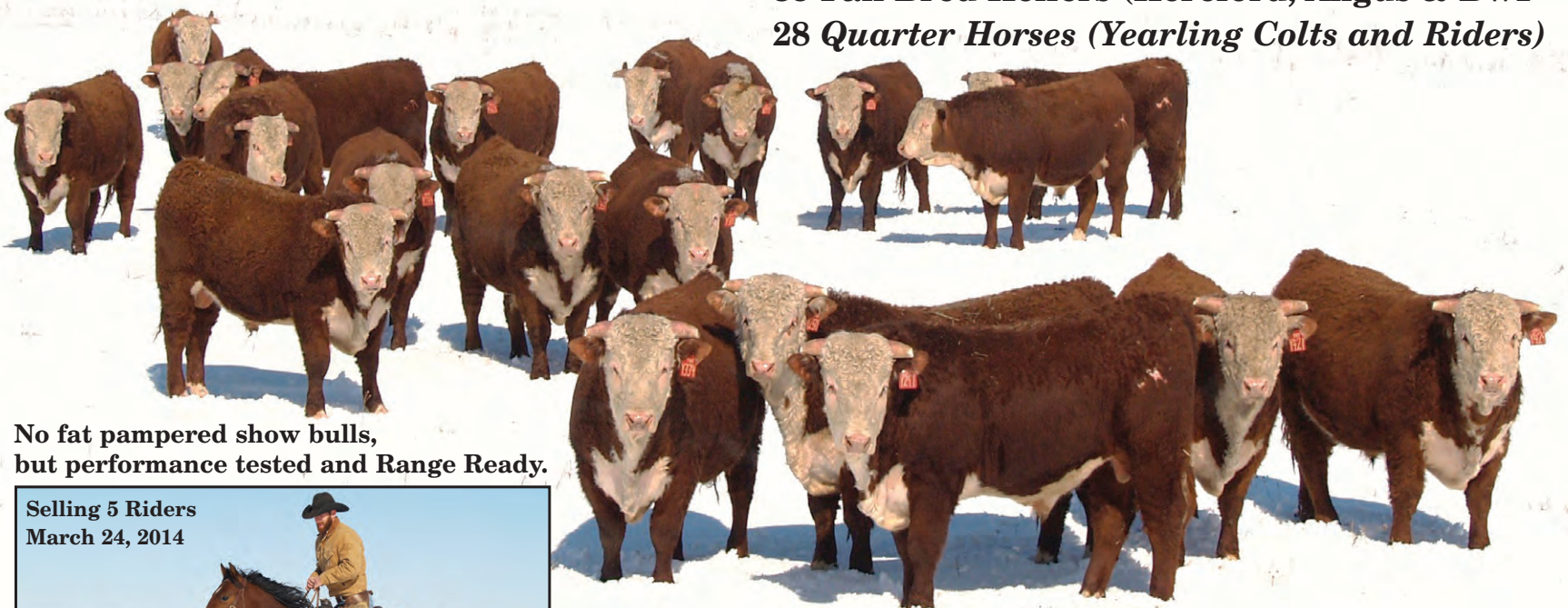

Fiscal year 2013 has been a record-setting year in many ways for the Hereford breed, and the inaugural Hereford Heritage Award is a continuation of the trend. For the first time ever, a breeder has registered 10,000 head total. Better yet, in this year alone, three ranches have achieved that level.

This achievement prompted the American Hereford Association (AHA) to create an award to commemorate such a milestone. CK Ranch, Brookville, KS; Dudley Bros., Comanche, TX and Upstream Ranch, Taylor, NE, are the recipients of this award commemorating their unprecedented level of commitment to the Hereford breed. They were recognized during AHA's Annual Meeting Nov. 1 in Kansas City, MO.

CK Ranch

CK Ranch is located in the Smoky Hills region of Saline and Ellsworth Counties of central Kansas. Jack and Donna Vanier and their son, John, own the ranch and the cowherd. Ray and Mary Negus manage the ranch.

The ranch includes approximately 15,000 acres of native pastures and 1,000 acres of tillable crop ground. The Vanier family has owned the land since 1933, when the 5,600-acre Root Ranch was purchased.

CK Ranch was first stocked with steers, but in the 1950s the ranch managed 2,000 registered cows and registered approximately 1,200 calves each year. Currently the CK commercial herd consists of 600 Hereford and Red Angus cows, and 175 registered Hereford cows make up the seedstock herd.

The primary purpose of the commercial cows is to serve as a testing herd to prove Hereford and Red Angus genetics. CK Ranch uses premium programs to collect data and to improve traits in the commercial herd. The ranch has participated in the AHA National Reference Sire Evaluation Program and the Hereford Verified program.

Dudley Bros.

Established in 1925, Dudley Bros. was originally a mercantile and ranching partnership by brothers, Gail, Tom and Eltos Dudley but is operated today by Gail's sons, John, Jim and T.J., and Eltos's sons, Tom, Ray and Harry.

Dudley Bros. is a family owned and operated registered and commercial Hereford enterprise, headquartered in Comanche County, Texas. Dudley Bros. has been in the registered Hereford business since 1938 and is known for producing practical and adaptable commercially oriented bulls and females that work well throughout all the regions of Texas and the surrounding states.

Dudley Bros. holds a production sale each year in October at the ranch headquarters two miles southwest of Comanche with an offering of 125 two-year-old bulls. Females are normally sold private treaty in the late spring. Dudley Bros.' herd bull battery includes individuals that represent the best in horned beef Hereford genetics, and the ranch adds several young prospects each year from top ranches across the United States.

The Dudleys are also known for producing top quality and practical registered Quarter horses, and Dudley Bros. is an iconic name among the annals of Texas ranching history.

Upstream Ranch

Alfred Meeks and Sons originated in 1937 in Dalhart, Texas, when Alfred Meeks bought some heifers from his father, JD Meeks. In 1955 Alfred and his wife, Mildred, and their son and daughter-in-law, Ferrall and Gloria, purchased Upstream Ranch near Taylor in the Sandhills of Nebraska.

Today the ranch is managed by Alfred's grandson, Brent, and his wife, Robin, and owned with Mildred, who

still lives on the ranch. Brent and Robin have two children — Marshall and Carlee. Alfred succumbed to cancer in 1991, and Ferrall and Gloria were tragically lost in a car accident in 1994. Brent and Robin have carried on the tradition of the Upstream Ranch name.

Upstream Ranch calves out 1,000 head of registered calves each year, with half calving in the spring and half in the fall. The Meeks are known for their intensive AI (artificial insemination) and ET (embryo transfer)

programs. Upstream hosted its first production sale at the ranch in 1978, which has continued annually on the first Saturday of February. The ranch's main focus is the production of stout, rugged range bulls for commercial cattlemen.

Genetically, Upstream Ranch is trying to produce cattle with balanced-

trait selection. The Meeks are constantly striving for the proper balance of calving ease, growth, maternal, fertility and carcass traits. They are advocates of using expected progeny differences (EPDs) and ultrasound but also make sure their cattle excel in phenotype and temperament. Structural soundness and disposition are critical.

Lawrence Inducted Into Hereford Hall of Fame; Boyd to Hall of Merit

Truman Lawrence, Somerset, KY, was inducted into the Hereford Hall of Fame at the American Hereford Association (AHA) Annual Meeting. The Hall of Fame honor annually recognizes breeders who've dynamically influenced the direction and advancement of the Hereford breed.

Truman Lawrence started as a "horseback-riding, roping cowboy in Oklahoma and Texas" according to longtime customers of his, Mary and Bill Mericka, Triple M Ranch, Browns Summit, NC, but worked his way to be one of the most well-respected and beloved Hereford farm managers in the country.

Truman managed McIntosh, Double L and Poca Dot Hereford farms over the years and then spent 25 years working for Morlunda Farms, Lewisburg, WV. When Truman began managing Morlunda in 1960, the farm was a horned operation, and Truman was able to transition it to one of the best Polled Hereford herds in the country.

Dr. Donald Richardson, Crozet, VA, says he made many trips to Morlunda with his father, Warren, while Truman was manager. "Truman was my father's favorite cowperson of all time," Dr. Richardson said in his enthusiastic endorsement of Truman's induction into the Hall of Fame.

"Truman was a superb fitter and shower of cattle," Dr. Richardson adds.

While Truman was managing Mor-

lunda, it won many banners for excellent show cattle and was owned by the Nelson family. During Truman's employment in 1968, the Morlunda show string traveled across the country to more shows than any other farm. Truman also gained national respect as a judge.

The Merickas have nothing but the utmost respect and admiration of Truman. "Truman was a real believer in trying to improve the breed. He went to Canada and bought cattle to increase frame size. He believed in records and kept detailed ones before that became the thing to do," they wrote in recommendation.

Truman was also focused on youth, spending much of his time mentoring young cattlemen and women. Bill Nelson attests to this. "All the grandchildren thought of Truman as a second father," Nelson says.

The late Oscar Nelson, Jr., who was Truman's employer at Morlunda was quoted as saying, "Truman is an expert judge of cattle. He's also an excellent salesman, but more than these things, the one thing that is dear to my heart is his ability and desire to work with young people."

Dale Stith, an auctioneer from Maysville, KY, has known Truman Lawrence for 35 years. "Mr. Lawrence has been a mentor and teacher to an untold number of young and old alike.

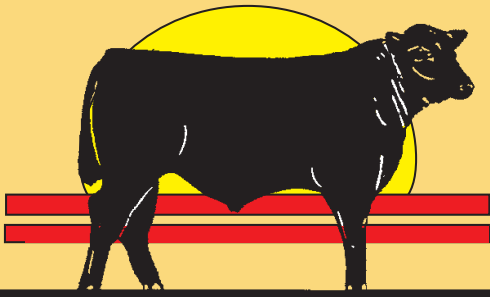

Dorian Garrick, Ames, IA, was inducted into the Hereford Hall of Merit. Garrick is a professor of animal science at Iowa State University. In 1981 he earned his bachelor's degree in agricultural science from Massey Univer-



sity in his home country of New Zealand and then a doctorate from Cornell in 1988. He was named to the Jay Lush Endowed Chair in Animal Breeding and Genetics at Iowa State in 2007. He is also the executive director of the National Beef Cattle Evaluation Consortium.

Garrick's current research projects are to improve the accuracy of predicted genetic and phenotypic merit using high-density genomic information. Generally his work focuses on the portfolio of endeavors that are involved in the design, enhancement, implementation and monitoring of genetic improvement programs. These include aspects of genetics, economics, statistics and biology. Attention is directed at variance component estimation, prediction of breeding values, development of breeding objectives, exploitation of breed/heterosis effects and breeding industry structure, primarily in regard to their application to the national improvement of beef cattle, but other species are also considered.

His Hereford connection comes from his research. Garrick has been instrumental in developing and implementing genomic information into the Hereford genetic evaluation. His work has allowed Hereford to be the first beef breed to develop and market its own genomic-enhanced expected progeny differences (GE-EPDs).

AHA Chief Operating Officer and Director of Breed Improvement and Jack Ward explains Garrick's influence on the Hereford breed. "This may be the most important genetic improvement tool that has ever been developed and with his leadership, the AHA has positioned itself to utilize this information to continue to identify genetics within the breed that will be useful to the seedstock industry and ultimately continue to create demand for Hereford genetics within the commercial industry. Dorian is recognized worldwide for his expertise in the area of genomics and the AHA has been fortunate to work side by side with him.
