## Rausch, Shaw Top Hereford Dams of Distinction List: South Dakota, Nebraska, Kansas Top States

The American Hereford Association (AHA) recently announced that Hereford herds in 43 states gained the distinction of being named to the Dams of Distinction list for calendar year 2013. In this list were 2,386 Hereford cows

The American Hereford Association problems. A Dam of Distinction is the AHA) recently announced that Here-ord herds in 43 states gained the disconnection problems. A Dam of Distinction is the standard by which all Hereford cows can be judged.

Problems. A Dam of Distinction is the excel. Only a small portion of active cows is recognized. All heifers have the potential of being a Dam of Distinction,

The cow must do her job, but also her owner must manage the herd correctly to give her the opportunity to excel. Only a small portion of active cows is recognized. All heifers have the potential of being a Dam of Distinction, but only a small percentage fit the job description of an ideal cow year in and year out.

In order for a cow to be named a 2013 Dam of Distinction she must have the achieved following: Weaned a calf born since January 1, 2012; produced at least three calves; initially calved at 30 months of age or less; had an interval between the first and second calves of no greater than 400 days. In addition, a 370-day calving interval must have been maintained after her second calf. The longer initial calving interval allows breeders to calve two-year-old heifers prior to the mature cow herd.

It is also required of a Dam of Distinction that every calf produced that was born before June 30, 2012, must have weaning records submitted to the Hereford Performance Program.

She must also have progeny average

from 679 Hereford herds.

For 33 years Rausch Herefords, Hoven, SD, has led Hereford breeders with the most cows qualifying as Dams of Distinction. With 381 cows recognized, South Dakota is the top state again this year.

The 2013 Dams of Distinction list honors the Hereford breed's cows who meet the highest standard of production and recognizes the cattlemen who produce them. In order to be named a Dam of Distinction, a Hereford cow must meet all the job requirements for an ideal cow. She should produce a healthy, growthy calf every year; she should calve as a two-year-old, and she should cause her owner absolutely no



Shaw Cattle Co., Caldwell/Notus, ID, was second on the Dams of Distinction list with 37 females who earned the distinction.

205-day adjusted weaning weight ratio of at least 105.

#### **Sires of Distinction**

Also recognized are Sires of Distinction. The Sires of Distinction program recognizes superior Hereford bulls. The American Hereford Association Board of Directors initiated the pro(continued on page 6)



ness. When Ross talked with you, he would get pretty close to you and speak in a kind of whisper that made you feel like he was telling you some things that nobody else knew.

Since I was still in high school and had studying to do, and needed my sleep, I only stayed up to listen to the conversation until about nine o'clock and then I would excuse myself.

The morning after this particular night, I was informed that Ross was going to line up for me, the opportunity to serve as herdsmen apprentice at Dan Thornton's Gunnison Hereford Ranch in Gunnison, CO the following summer. This was somewhat of a shock to me because I had not heard of this planning before and I had previously been selected to go to the Montana's Boy's State to represent our school.

This event was to be held in June and our high school football team was favored to win conference the next fall, so this plan was upsetting to me as it was to my girlfriend, who later became

Just about everybody that was anybody in the Hereford business knew of Dan Thornton, and his cattle that he called the TT Triumphants, so I thought, I couldn't pass up this opportunity. I agreed to drop all of my school activities for the summer, and looked forward to my big job experience in Colorado.

As I prepared to leave home with one small suitcase, and wearing my western hat, I said goodbyes to my Mother and Dad, and was taken to the airport in Bozeman by one of our hired hands. I had never flown on a big plane before and I would be going to Denver, with stops in Billings, Sheridan, Casper and Cheyenne, with the final stop in Denver/ Stapleton. I was flying on a new airline called Frontier, in a Douglas DC3, which was the civilian version of a military C47. In those days there were very few direct flights. Flights were pretty much from one city to another where there might be passenger potential. I had a friend from Twin Bridges, who at that time was serving in the Army High Mountain Assault Division south of Colorado Springs. We had kept in contact with each other through frequent letters. In fact, he was one of our closest neighbors, a young man by

the name of Bob Lott. When Bob heard I was coming to Colorado, he wrote and told me that he would meet me at the airport in Denver and take me over the mountain to Gunnison, CO.

When I arrived at Denver there was no big terminal like there is today, just a little shack where the plane unloaded the passengers; we just walked off the plane, picked up our suitcases and passengers were either met by their people or got a cab to town.

I waited at the shack for about two hours and was starting to get restless because there was no one around and I had no way of communicating with my friend, Bob. In the middle of the afternoon, I heard the whine of a motorcycle coming and as the motorcycle approached I realized that it was Bob on his big old Indian motorcycle, coming to pick me up. I don't know how many of you know motorcycles but this big old Indian must have weighed 1200 pounds and it made a huge amount of noise. There was no place to put the suitcase on the motorcycle, so when I sat behind Bob I had to pull my hat down to my ears and hang on to the suitcase with the other hand.

Bob whipped through Denver and got out onto the main highway between Denver and Colorado Springs. I was having trouble holding the suitcase with one hand and holding onto my hat with the other while balancing on the old Indian. It felt like we were going pretty fast and when I got a glance over Bob's shoulder to see the speedometer, we were traveling at 120 miles per hour. This was a new experience to me because 120 miles an hour was awfully fast, especially when you are hanging on to a suitcase with one hand and a hat with the other.

We made it safely to Colorado Springs and Bob said he knew of a hotel that he said I had to see, because it was one of the great hotels in the world. We stopped at the Broadmoor Hotel and looked around and it certainly was a really grand hotel, unlike any I had seen before. In Montana we had no grand hotels except in the National Parks.

After a quick tour, Bob thought it was getting a little bit late, so suggested we get going to get a motel down the road and go over Monarch Pass, which is 11,312 feet high, the next morning to Gunnison. Then he would go back to Camp Carson.

When we got back to the Indian, we found it laying on its side on the pavement. We never did know if someone knocked it over or if we failed to get the stand in the right place. Both Bob & I were pretty strong at that time, but we could not get the old Indian back up on its wheels. We waited about an hour when two younger guys came by and we talked them into helping us get the motorcycle righted, then we headed on our way hoping to find a motel, as it was getting towards the end of the day. We cut across the road to Camp Carson, where Bob was stationed, and headed to Canon City, where he thought

we could find a hotel. We didn't have much money and we didn't find much of a motel, in fact, it was one of the worst dumps that I have ever stayed in, and we pushed a dresser against the door for security.

We got up early the next morning to head out to our final destination of Gunnison. Things were going fine until we stared to head up Monarch Pass. About half way up the pass the old Indian started to miss and within a mile or two the engine died! Bob did what he could to get the engine running but it was to no avail, so we sat beside the road and tried to figure out what we

could do next.

After about an hour of waiting, and discussing the issue, an old pickup truck came chugging up the road, it stopped beside us and we noticed an older couple in the front and two kids sitting in the back. The older man said it looks like you two are having trouble, and we explained our situation.

He said, "You know boys, if we can get the motorcycle in the back of my pickup I'll (continued on page 4





give you a ride to Gunnison because that is where we are headed."

Well we thought the ride was a good idea, but how were we going to get the big old Indian up into the back of the pickup? We walked up and down the road looking for some boards that might hold the Indian, while we pushed it up, and we finally found some planks that were on a snow fence, beside the road, about a quarter of a mile away. We got the planks off of the snow fence and the old fella and his wife and Bob and I pushed the old Indian up into the back of the pickup.

It was quite a trip from there to Gunnison because it was chilly and slow, but with Bob and I, and the two kids and the old Indian in the back of the truck, we made the trip without any further problem. The old man knew of a place in Gunnison where they could work on the Indian and he took us to the shop where we unloaded the motorcycle. We said our thanks and goodbyes to the old folks and then I called Thornton's ranch and arranged for a

When the bike was fixed Bob would be headed back to Camp Carson and I was on my way to a summer in the high mountains of Colorado. I worked under two of the best herdsmen in the U.S. at that time and I learned a great deal about feeding and fitting cattle and working around all of the notable people in the Hereford business that

came to visit. It was hard work, but I was used to that: we got up in the morning at four o'clock to do our chores and we didn't get done until about eight o'clock at night, when the cattle were turned out to their night pens.

Many of you that are reading this are probably too young to realize that Thornton's main promotional event was the Denver Stock Show. Thornton raised international interest when he sold two bulls at the Denver Stock Show sale for \$50,000 a piece that would probably convert to about a million dollars per bull today.

The Brown Palace was a famous hotel that catered to the rich and famous, and Dan Thornton always ace. People were shocked

when Dan talked the management of the Brown Palace to putting the two \$50,000 dollar bulls in pens in the lobby of their fancy hotel.

Thornton's dispersed the herd the following year after I had served my internship there and my dad and I went back to take in the big sale, which at the time was a huge international event.

All of this was a great experience for me and I made friendships that were carried on for life in the Hereford industry. I went home from Gunnison to finish my high school and college education and then went on to serve my country in the Air Force, after which I came back to the ranch and our Herefords, and my family. Bob Lott would serve his tour in the Army Mountain Division and then go on to veterinary school at Washington State University where he became a veterinarian.

Bob also came back to Twin Bridges where he had a veterinary practice in our valley for over 50 years and he worked as our veterinarian for those 50 years. He also helped me show our cattle for several years, however Bob's days with the motorcycles were done and the big old Indian was the last motorcycle Bob owned, however we did learn to fly airplanes at a later time.

As I mentioned previously, Dan Thornton would go on to be the Governor of Colorado, and was later on the short list of the persons chosen to run with Dwight Eisenhower, as his presidential candidate for President of the Unites States! Richard Nixon was the final choice.

Dan would probably have been chosen had Colorado had the votes that California was able to present in the election. Dan would earn nationwide recognition as the cowboy with a big hat and a great smile, who almost always had a pipe in his face. Dan judged many shows later and he was always great to me, wherever we met. He was

such a dynamic man, and could easily have become another John Wayne in the movies, or our Vice President. Both Dan and his wonderful wife, Jessie, (who I sat by for lunch for almost three months, while working at Thornton's), died before their time. These are great memories from interesting times in my life. It has really been an interesting life! Take care and more "rest of the stories later."

Up in our neck of the woods we say so long to the Marty family who has raised commercial Hereford cattle for many, many years. Their dispersion will have been held by now at the St. Onge Livestock Market in St. Onge,

The ranch was homesteaded in 1907 by William "Bill" Marty, Sr., grandfather of the current principle owners Sam and Jesse, father of Bill and John Marty who operated under Marty Bros.

In the early years the ranch raised sheep and in 1937 Hereford cattle were added and the sheep phased out. The Marty family continued to expand the ranch over the years. Brothers Bill and John Marty along with their sons Jess and Sam operated the ranch.

In this area they were known for their large groups of beautiful two and three-year-old Hereford steers (with horns) which were sold at local auction markets. The steers were trailed to market in Newell or Belle Fourche up until 1945. The practice of selling older steers endured until 1999 when they started selling yearling steers and transported them by truck.

Wonderful people who loved their cattle and lifestyle for a long time, they found an opportunity to retire and are doing so. We will miss you friends!

The Livestock Marketeers inducted three industry professionals into their Hall of Fame during the National Western Stock Show.


The Livestock Marketeers — an informal fraternity of livestock fieldmen, auctioneers, sale managers and related livestock business leaders — met for their 49th Annual Banquet at the National Western Club on Jan. 18. The event is hosted by American Live Stock.

The 2014 honorees included Jack Lowderman of Macomb, IL, and Lynn Weishaar of Reva, SD. Terry Robinson of Bismarck, ND, was honored posthumously.

Master of ceremonies was J. Neil Orth, executive vice president of the American-International Charolais Association and a 1984 Hall of Fame inductee. He opened the banquet with recordings of both Lowderman and Weishaar from the 1977 World Livestock Auctioneer Championship competition.

The Livestock Marketeers group was initiated in 1965 by Harry Green, Ross Miller and Claud Willett. Their purpose was to form a fraternal organization of livestock professionals, and to make annual awards in order to encourage younger members of the industry to succeed in their chosen profession.

#### Jack Lowderman

Jack's involvement with the livestock industry has been life-long. He worked side-by-side with his father, buying and selling commercial cows and bulls in his youth. Following high school, he graduated from Reisch College of Auctioneering and became owner/operator and auctioneer of a livestock market for six years.

In 1968, he formed an auction partnership with Tommy Williams, a purebred Angus breeder; they actively continued for 17 years, conducting livestock, real estate, personal property and farm machinery auctions.

In 1976, Jack began a 30-year run as the lead auctioneer at F&T Commission Company in Palmyra, MO. He also auctioned commercial livestock at four community weekly markets, purebred cattle for breeders and associations, and numerous production tested bull sales in Missouri and Illinois. He's competed in the World Livestock Auctioneer Championships and has been named a champion or finalist in six of the annual contests.

Jack is the founder of Lowderman Auction Company, a family owned and operated marketing business that has grown to include his three sons. Today, the company conducts over 100 auctions yearly throughout the Midwest, marketing agricultural, residential and commercial real estate; personal property, including machinery and equip-

ment, antiques and collectibles; specialty items; vehicles; and estates.

Their 20-acre auction facility at Macomb, IL, features 20,000 square feet under one roof. One indoor sales pavilion hosts a monthly consignment auction with three rings of merchandise offered at any one time. A second building with a livestock sales arena is available for purebred cattle auctions of all breeds.

As an auctioneer for Williams & Williams, a Tulsa, OK-based company that markets residential and commercial real estate, Jack travels nationwide. He is a graduate of the Certified Appraisal Institute, compiling both real and personal property evaluations.

Jack and his wife, Sherry, began their commitment to the Hereford breed when they were given two Polled Hereford cows as a wedding gift from her dad. As the family grew to include four sons, the cattle numbers expanded as well.

Today, the Lowderman Cattle Company is truly a family operation with sons, daughters-in-law, and grandchildren: Monte, Carrie and Rhett; Brent, Kris, Blake and Morgan; Cody and Abby; and son, Cory, always in their hearts.

The herd has grown to include 200 mother cows, 30 recips, and the 2013 National Western Stock Show Champion Hereford Bull. They hold an annual sale on the third Sunday of Sep-

tember. The family was honored in 2013 with the Seedstock Producer of the Year award from the Illinois Beef Association, as well as Breeder of the Year honors from the Illinois Hereford Association.

Jack served as a 4-H leader for 10 years, president and board member of the Illinois Polled Hereford Association, and a member of the Illinois Beef Council and Illinois Beef Association.

Tommy Williams of Tulsa, OK, and Delvin Heldermon of Sulphur, OK, roasted Jack at the Livestock Marketeers banquet.

#### Lynn Weishaar

"I hung around auction barns every chance I got," Lynn Weishaar recalls. He started pretending to sort and sell baby calves on his family's ranch near Lemmon, SD, when he was four or five years old.

So began a passion for the lifestyle that has lasted his whole life.

While in high school, Lynn began working for Robert Schnell, who ran the sale barn in Lemmon. He credits Schnell for getting him started in livestock marketing. He attended the Western College of Auctioneering in Billings, MT, and later graduated from North Dakota State University, where he was active in college rodeo and on the judging teams.

After college, he returned to the Lemmon area, leased a ranch, and be-

gan selling at that sale barn; it was his first real job selling livestock. Lynn soon took on the barns at Faith and Philip, sold at Sturgis until it closed down, and now sells at Philip and Belle Fourche on a weekly basis.

Lynn also sells registered horse and cattle sales across the country — from Canada to Texas and from Iowa to the West Coast — traveling to up to 300 sales a year and thousands of miles.

In the 1970s, Lynn started a consignment horse sale for proven ranch and arena horses that has caught on nation-wide. This type of sale has opened up a reliable source for marketing good horses, and for the buyer to find a dependable product. It has given him the opportunity to sell some of the greatest horses in the country, and has been a big influence on the horse industry in the central United States.

Lynn says selling livestock at auction is challenging, especially with fluctuating markets and political developments on the national level. But he still likes his job. He loves the excitement and the fast pace.

Best of all, he said, "I deal with the best people and the best stock in the world on a daily basis."

Weishaar's clients say, "nobody works harder at his business," "a total pro," and "the cattle and horse industry in western South Dakota wouldn't be all that it is today if not for him."

"This coming year I will strive to make Hereford a brand that is synonymous for high quality and the rancher's choice for added profit," Steve adds. "This will be achieved by a strong marketing campaign, dedicated staff and product placement. The breed continues to improve through genomic research and our members' will to drive the demand for Hereford seedstock. I truly believe we are poised to be the great genetic resource we once were. We need to keep our eye on the prize so our future will be golden."

Steve has served as a director of the California/Nevada Polled Hereford Association since 2002. In addition, he has been very active in local government and other community organizations, including serving as mayor of Paradise and being Butte County Supervisor. He has three children.

Selected to serve as the 2014 AHA vice president was Eric Walker, Morrison, TN. Eric inherited the love of the Hereford breed from his father, Sam Walker, who was a weighmaster at the local stockyard and raised commercial Hereford cattle.

In 1981 Eric purchased his first registered Hereford, and now, 32 years later, he owns and manages a herd of 125 registered Hereford cows along with his family — wife, Rhonda; son, Cody; and a stepson, Casey.

The Walkers have utilized artificial insemination (AI) since 1982, embryo transfer (ET) since 1989 and collected ultrasound data since 1999. The farm has hosted 17 production sales since

1986, selling Walker genetics into 32 states as well as Canada, Mexico and the United Kingdom.

The Walker cow herd utilizes approximately 500 acres of Eric's total 1,100-acre farming operation. The remaining 600 acres are used for the production of shade and ornamental trees and shrubs that supply products for Walker Nursery Co. Eric is the sole proprietor of Walker Nursery Co., and

he sells and markets his products to the landscape and retail green industry, shipping to 35 different states.

Completing their terms on the AHA Board were outgoing president Cliff Copeland, Nara Visa, NM; Marty Lueck, Mountain Grove, MO; and Dale Micheli, Ft. Bridger, WY.

#### **Terry Robinson**


Jeff Thomas remembers Terry Robinson as "always a General, and a great mentor."

He married Joyce, his high school sweetheart, in 1969 and raised two children, Cade (April) and Kree (Troy) Nelson; they have eight grandchildren.



Barber, Austin, TX; Dave Bielema, Ada, MI.; and Joe Van Newkirk, Oshkosh, NE, will serve four-year terms on the 12-member Board.

#### Terri Barber

Terri Barber, Austin, TX, has been involved in the Hereford business since birth. Her family owns and operates Barber Ranch, Channing, TX.

Founded in 1904, Barber Ranch was a 2004 honoree of the Texas Family Land Heritage Program for being in continuous family ownership for 100 years. Herefords have been the mainstay of the Barber program since the beginning, with the herd currently consisting of 200 registered females.

The Barber family uses extensive AI and ET in their efforts to offer customers the best genetics available. They host an annual bull sale in November in San Saba – the heart of the Texas Hill

Show heifer/donor prospects are sold in special sales in the spring and fall. Due to the severe drought in their area, they have enlisted cooperator herds to take advantage of raising more embryo calves, thereby increasing the number and quality of cattle produced. To increase marketing efforts, the Barbers also exhibit at the national shows.

Along with assisting on the ranch as time permits, since 2007 Terri has worked for Elanco Animal Health as its beef stocker sales representative for south and central Texas and Louisiana. In this role she calls on beef producers, veterinarians and academia within her territory. She has also served as Elanco's branded beef marketing associate and has worked directly with premier branded programs in the U.S.

Terri is a member of the Texas Hereford Association and is currently serving as vice president. She is also a past president of the Texas Hereford Auxiliary.

#### **Dave Bielema**

Michigan Hereford breeder Dave Bielema got his start in the Hereford business when his daughters began showing 4-H cattle.

Today, Grand Meadows Farm, Ada, MI has grown to 50 registered Hereford spring calving cows along with a dozen fall-calving recipient cows. A family operation, with no outside help, the Bielemas transfer about 30 embryos per year and have a strong AI program.

In 2009 Dave started Great Lakes Hereford Beef (GLHB) to pool Michigan Hereford-influenced feeder calves and to provide price support by selling cattle to feedlots on a grid and to offer an entry point for Michigan cattle into the Certified Hereford Beef (CHB) program. GLHB purchases the feeder calves from local breeders, and after a short backgrounding period, the cattle are hauled to a Kansas feedlot. GLHB retains half ownership and at harvest collects carcass data, which is provided back to the breeders.

The Bielemas also have a produce farm that direct markets locally grown produce to more than 100 customers.

Dave is a member, as well as a previous board member, of the Michigan Hereford Association. He is also currently serving on the AHA online systems development test committee.

Along with managing the farm-related businesses, Dave is an orthopaedic surgeon and a partner in Orthopaedic Ventures LLC. He is and has been a member of various hospital and orthopaedic boards and committees.

Dave and his wife, Jill, have three daughters - Lindsay (Gandy), Kara (Loney) and Kristin. All three daughters have been active in the National Junior Hereford Association (NJHA). Kristin, his youngest daughter, is currently serving on the NJHA board. Jill just retired from serving on the National Hereford Women board.

#### Joe Van Newkirk

Nebraska Hereford breeder Joe Van Newkirk, Oshkosh, NE, has been involved in the Hereford business his entire life. The ranch was established in 1892 by Joe's grandfather, L.D. Van Newkirk. Joe's father, A.J., started the registered operation in the 1940s.

Van Newkirk Herefords is managed much like most commercial ranching operations in the Nebraska Sandhills. The cow herd grazes Sandhills' grass and crop residues nine months a year. The calves are weaned and wintered on the ranch.

Sale bulls are summered on grass and offered for sale at the Van Newkirks' annual bull sale in January. The Van Newkirk family calves out approximately 450 registered Hereford cows each spring. They usually raise enough feed along the North Platte River to sustain the cow herd and calves.

They have used AI since the early '70s, using predominately their own herd sires' semen. To ensure accurate comparison between cows, the Van Newkirks have never creep fed their calves. Complete performance and ultrasound data are taken on each calf

This year will be their 41st annual sale. They will be selling 120 2-yearold bulls, 50 yearling bulls and about 100 heifer calves. Most of the sale bulls and heifers are sold to area commercial ranches.

Joe's objective in his breeding program is to raise practical cattle that will thrive in their climate — cattle with substance and good-doing ability to handle the extreme weather swings of western Nebraska.

He is a member of the Nebraska Hereford Association (NHA) and served on the NHA board in the 1980s. He is also a member of the Sandhills Cattle Association and the Nebraska Cattlemen.

Joe and his wife, Cyndi, have three grown children.

## AHA Announces Spring 2014 Gold TPR Breeders

Eighty-nine dedicated Hereford breeders achieved Gold TPRTM (Total Performance Records) status for spring 2014, according to the American Hereford Association (AHA).

The Gold TPR Breeder recognition is presented to progressive Hereford breeders who have measured traits and collected and promptly submitted performance data at all levels of production.

"The reason the Gold TPR program was established was to recognize those breeders who go the extra mile to collect data at all levels of production and report that data in a timely manner," says AHA Chief Operating Officer and Director of Breed Improvement Jack Ward.

Since the program's inception in 2005, Hereford breeders have increased their data collection efforts.

Breeders must meet a specific set of requirements in order to be eligible for the program. They are:

- Herd inventory submitted prior to date inventory surcharge goes into effect.
- Complete reporting of calving ease and reproductive status for each dam on inventory
- · Complete reporting of birth weights for all live calves recorded in the calf crop.
- Complete reporting of weaning weights for all live calves recorded in the calf crop.
- Complete reporting of yearling weights for all live calves recorded in the calf crop.
- Complete reporting of scrotal measurements for each bull calf with a recorded
- yearling weight. Ultrasound data reported on 25% or
