In honor of my dad's 85th birthday on the 9th of this month, we are giving him a pass on writing an editorial. He skipped the coun-

try and took a little vacation in Arizona with my sister. Happy Birthday Dad!

The Denver Stock Show was a tremendous showcase for Hereford cattle like we have not seen in many years. Not only did we have record numbers, but our breed also garnered the honors of having the highest sale average of all the cattle breeds with 41 lots averaging \$30,421. The high selling animal was Lot 7, NJW PMH 66X 156T Luxe 202A ET, a bred heifer from Ned and Jan Ward, Sheridan, WY and Pablo Herrera, Buenos Aires, Argentina selling for \$250,000 to Eduardo de la Tour, Boca Raton, FL. Congratulations to the Wards and Herreras. The National Hereford Sale was incredibly exciting. Held in the same area as the shows are held earlier in the day, the entire infield was full of people as were half of the stands up above. It is estimated about 5,000 people were in attendance.

The pen and carload shows were extraordinary with tremendous quality in the 10 carloads, 39 pens of bulls and 21 pens of heifers. The AHA says the Yard numbers were up 94 head from last year with a total of 278 head of Herefords!

The "frozen genetics" sale, Mile High Eve, also saw unbelievable prices for rights to flush, flushes and embryo packages. Topping that

Olsen Ranches Inc.: Progressiveness rooted in Herefords

Diversified, dedicated and driven come to mind when describing the Olsen family. Four generations deep, today Art Olsen and his son Douglas Olsen continue to build on the occupation of farming and ranching, a job the Olsen men have loved since Lars Olsen first arrived in Banner County, NE in 1885.

"My grandfather, Lars Olsen, came from Denmark. He stopped in Kansas for five or six years, then took off with his family and headed west. He got to Antelopeville, which is now Kimball, NE and headed north. My dad kept asking him, 'when will we get there?' And he would reply, 'whenever we quit.' When he pulled up here he stopped, looked around, and

said, 'this is home,'" recalled Art Olsen of how his family came to live near Harrisburg, NE.

From the beginning, the Olsens had livestock. Farming was not prevalent in western Nebraska at the time, and the family only raised enough crops to feed themselves. When Lars' son settled down in the 1920s, he began raising



cattle in earnest, and to the best of anyone's knowledge they were Hereford influenced.

"We often trailed our cattle to Denver to sell in those days. On one trip dad when downtown to Market Street to look for some help after selling. Well, he wasn't too clean after trailing cattle that far, and while he was looking for help the cops came along and threw him in jail. The next morning they asked him what he was going to do, and he replied that they should probably call his banker in Scottsbluff. They did, and the banker told them they better let dad out before he bought the place and told them to leave. It was a funny experience, and one of the more memorable trips," said Art with a chuckle.

When Art and his wife Sharon were married in the 1960s, he thought adding some registered Hereford cattle to the operation would be a good idea.

"We sold bulls for several years. Then came the 1980s, and Herefords weren't very popular. So, I just put my registration papers in a box and kept raising the same cattle as I was before. I just didn't tell anyone about the registered part," said Art.

The operation continued to grow and change over time. Farming became more prevalent in the area and Red Angus genetics were added to the Hereford cowherd to improve heterosis. Art's son Douglas also returned to the operation after college, and today he and Art work together with the much appreciated help of both family and non-family team members to run a highly diversified operation whose backbone remains Hereford based cattle.

"We run a commercial herd of cattle that probably average 7/8 Hereford and 1/8 Red Angus, as well as a smaller registered herd of Herefords. We farm multiple crops, and really like this area

because there is a good combination of grassland and farmland. That provides us the option to put our cows on cornstalks for most of the winter months, and also enables us to feed our own cattle as well as outside cattle," said Douglas.

Olsens put their own steers on feed from June 1 to around December 1 each year, filling their lots with outside cattle the remaining months. Last year's steers graded 95 percent choice or prime, a fact the family is proud of.

"We credit that to our selection methods and the genetics we have been able to use, particularly through the National Reference Sire Program. Through that program we use semen from 10-12 different Hereford sires randomly mated to our commercial cows, then feed the offspring and collect data on their performance. We've been involved in that program since 1998, and as a result of our involvement decided to install a Growsafe system in our feedlot in 2010 to better collect data for that enterprise as well as for anyone else that would like custom data collected for themselves," explained Douglas.



"Dr. Jerry Taylor with the University of Missouri does a lot of the presentation of that data and genomic comparisons, and has said how much he appreciates the quality of clean data that comes from this setup to help the Hereford breed. Plus, both dad and I love the genetic aspect of raising cattle, and really enjoy being able to see how different genetics perform in our environment. We have really enjoyed our involvement in the National Reference Sire Program, and the fact that it has provided us the ability to do some high quality research in our own operation," explained Douglas.

One result of testing a variety of Hereford bloodlines was a resurgence of the registered side of Olsen's herd in recent years. Art and Douglas began marketing bulls private treaty in about 2007, before transitioning to an annual bull sale four years ago.

"As the registered herd developed, we had bulls we could offer for sale. We also found that most of our customers wanted similar bulls, and with first-come, first-serve basis that goes with private treaty sales, that was hard to facilitate. So, we started a sale and offer coming two-year old bulls," said Douglas.

On the female side, Olsen's select for reduced birth weights, moderate growth, moderate milk and carcass traits.


"We have a passion to raise a product that is desirable for the consumer, and we finish our own cattle, so there is an emphasis on rib eye area and marbling in our herd that is hard to match. We also want a cow that can take care of herself. We start calving May 20, calves are weaned in mid-November, and our cows go out to cornstalks until April or May again," explained Douglas.

All cows are AI'd, with 97 percent typically being heat detected each year. Replacement heifers are AI'd once, and no clean up bulls are turned out in those heifers.

"It's a one-chance deal to conceive, and what is bred is what we keep for our replacements. Then, we turn around and AI those heifers that didn't breed the first time to calve Sept. 1, and sell those as a premium product – people like the idea of having a 27 month old heifer when she calves," said Douglas.

Of Hereford cattle in general, Art said the family likes them for their docility, ability to care for themselves with minimal inputs as well as the fact that they complement other breeds so well.

When asked about sustaining an operation for over 100 years, Douglas said dedication toward executing plans made is at the top of the list. "Over the years it has also helped to be very diversified. We feel the farming enterprise nicely balances the cattle enterprise and allows us to utilize all the resources

available to us, including the farmland, in an integrated program. It's a lot about using the resources you have available to you appropriately and in a sustainable fashion."


Art added that he most enjoys the work involved, saying it's nice to do what you like to do, instead of having a job you have to do.

The bellwether of production sales in our region is always the Van Newkirk Sale in Oshkosh, NE. As the Denver sale, Van Newkirks had great success, averaging \$11,485 on 101 two-year olds! (A complete report will be in next month's issue.) So it looks like we are off and running with some powerful Hereford sales.

"It's been an exciting time for the Hereford breed," says Joe Rickabaugh, AHA director of seedstock marketing. "In addition to breaking a record with the high-selling lot, we saw 30 lots out of 40 lots bring \$10,000 or more. The last lot in the sale brought \$18,000, and there were eight lots over \$30,000."

Sale attendees came to see a show and that's just what they got. The Hereford offering, as always, was elite, and the bidding proved it. When auctioneers Eddie Burks and Rick Machado, silenced the gavel for the final time, \$1,382,350 had been spent. The 41 live lots grossed \$1,247,250 with an average of \$30,421. The five embryo lots more than doubled last year's average at \$8,270. One flush commanded \$15,500 and one semen lot brought \$78,250.

Topping the sale at \$250,000 was Lot 7, NJW PMH 66X 156T Luxe 202A ET, consigned by NJW Polled Herefords, Sheridan, Wyo., and Pablo Herrera, Buenos Aires, Argentina. The second high seller was Lot 18A, a one-third interest on H/TSR/CHEZ/ Full Throttle. He is a March 20, 2013. son of H WCC/WB 668 Wyarno 9500 ET and out of R Sweet Red Wine 039. Jeb Skiles, Dalhart, TX, paid \$120,000 for the one-third interest and one-third semen interest in this impressive bull from Hoffman Ranch, Thedford, NE. and Swanson Family Herefords, Peterson, IA.

The sale remained strong, as the third high seller commanded \$86,000. Lot 4, a half-interest in Perks 0003 Easy Money 4003, is a Jan. 1, 2014, son of BR Currency 8144 ET and out of PR 144U Ramona 0003 ET. He was consigned by Perks Ranch, Rockford, IL.
