zona a few weeks ago and I went down to the area south of Casa Grande and this brought back some old memories about people who fight and defend our country.

As a young man in my teens, I attended the University of Montana. During orientation time I ran into a young freshman man and we became immediate friends while visiting. He was a big guy about 6 feet 3 inches tall and he weighed about 225 pounds, a solid muscled guy with a big grin, but you knew he was all business. At freshman orientation we got talking about where we came from, what we had done and what our goals were for college. He told me that he was one of the first students in the new US Forest Service group that was being organized to jump (parachute) fire fighters into the mountains in the Northwest to fight and contain fires, this was a new program for the Forest Service and up until this time all of the fire fighters had to hike to the fires and in many cases it was a long hike, taking a long period of time, and sometimes they would lose control of the fire before the fire fighters could get to it.

It was interesting to me to have this conversation with my new friend because I had been recruited in high school for the same job and I was very interested in doing it, but my Dad vetoed the idea saying I was needed to work on the ranch in the summers not go off to fight fires. From now on in this story I will refer to my friend as "Scar" because, for security reasons, I don't want to use his real name.

During our time at the University of Montana, Scar would be gone from school for extended periods of time, when he would come back to school, of course, we would ask where he had been and what he had been up to, he always gave vague answers and said he was off earning more money to pay for school. Both Scar and I were to graduate at the same time but because of my commitment to the Air Force and what

Scar was doing, neither one of us could participate in the actual graduation ceremony.

I went right into Air Force duty and served some time in Texas, was transferred to Washington and then my final assignment took me to an isolated radar site at Yaak, MT.

Yaak was a smaller unit with only one squadron. We were there for early warning purposes and we also had intercept capabilities, which meant if we picked up a bogey on a radar we could scramble fighters out of the base in Spokane to intercept them; this was at

a time when we were very concerned about aggression from Russia.

My job was multipurpose, I was in charge of the Air Police unit on the base, which included perimeter security, logistics for the base, and because of the work I was doing I had "Secret Clearance." I finished my time in the Air Force and was released from active duty, went on to reserve status and came back to the ranch.

I had not heard from Scar since going into the Air Force, but some of my friends told me that periodically he came back to Missoula, like he

did during college days, and still had the same vague answers to his activities. After a few years back from the service I was receiving some flight instruction at Johnson Flying Service in Missoula. At this time Johnson Flying Service was in a world of their own because they were the first air service that was flying into the back country of the Northwest delivering supplies to the people who were fighting fires. Johnson got a good reputation worldwide as one of the great flying services. They had airplanes from very small utility

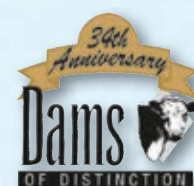

airplanes to the big old multi-engine bombers and cargo/passenger planes.

Bob Johnson, who was one of the Johnson brothers, was one of the great pilots in the United States and I've received much of my flight instruction advice from him. Johnson Flying Service at the time had one of the only air carrier permits in the United States which was not owned by one of the major airlines. Of course, along with the permit, was the Johnsons' expertise in the knowledge of flying anywhere, anytime, under any conditions.

About two years after I had done some of my aeronautical work with Johnson Flying Service I got a phone call from Scar and we asked each other

how each of us was doing and what was going on. Now, all Scar would tell me was that he was busy at a flying job which took him all over the world but he would not tell me anymore which was usual for Scar. However, Scar did ask what I knew about a young guy I will call "Tiger," again for security reasons. Scar wanted to know what I knew about Tiger since he had been told by Tiger that he grew up in Twin Bridges and that he knew me very well. Scar asked me a lot of questions about Tiger, his personality, his loyalty and many other things that he thought I might know about Tiger as a young man. Scar told me, "We have to know everything about a person before hiring and it is always good to get background from

someone who has known him from childhood to adulthood." When we were done discussing Tiger, Scar and I talked about a few other things and I told him I hoped it would not be too long before we talked again. We said goodbye and I hoped everything would go okay with Scar. Shortly thereafter I learned from Tiger's family that he had accepted a flying job but there were no other details available. The operation would be something secret because Scar wouldn't tell me too much about it.

About a year after, I got another call from Scar and he wondered if I would be interested in going in with him to buy Johnson Flying Service. Scar said, "You know the operation, I know the operation very well, and the air carrier certificate is one of the big things that we need in our business for it to work, and I need somebody like you to go in with me to buy it, what do you think?"

I was in somewhat of a shock because I had never thought of trying to buy into Johnson Flying Service and I had no idea I would ever be involved in such a big operation. I told Scar that I would have to look into it and see if it were possible to raise that kind of money. Scar told me that the money was available and that would not be of concern. I also told Scar that I would talk to him later and would he call me back within about a week and we will talk a little more about it then.

Going through my mind was just what is Scar into, and what is he working on, because knowing Johnson Flying Service would be good and could be an international operation, and with all the things that Scar wouldn't tell me about the last few years, I had to believe that this was a covert operation he was into. I would have to do some talking to my wife about this involvement. Pauline and I decided that the amount of money involved, even though available, would be a far reach for us at the time, even though with my interest in

flying it was certainly very interesting, but it was really very, very interesting to me to hear again from Scar and to wonder what he was headed for and what we might find out later. After due consideration, I had to decline the offer.

Not too long after that, maybe two years, Scar called me and asked how I was doing. I told him that we were raising registered Hereford cattle, doing a lot of things in the cattle business and I was flying around the country frequently. Scar told me he was now located in Arizona and would like to have me stop and visit him if I ever came down that way. I told him that I was scheduled to judge the Arizona National Hereford show in Phoenix in January and would like to see him and his wife, who also went to college with us. He said it would be wonderful if I could stop by and I asked him since we were flying, could we fly into where he was located. He told me to call him when we knew we were leaving for sure and he would give us detailed instructions about where we were to land and what the procedure would be.

After I had finished the judging job at the Arizona National, I called Scar and we made plans for us to come south and visit them the next day. Scar said he would call me back with the code which I would need to land at Marana Airbase. At the international airport in Phoenix we were assigned to take off on parallel runways with a Boeing 747,

and after takeoff we were assigned by the tower to fly right over the top of the 747 when at 300 feet, on his takeoff runway, and take a heading of 180 degrees. The 747 was assigned a heading of 090 degrees. Phoenix is an incredibly busy airport and you have to know that I was a little nervous with all of the big heavy traffic.

After maneuvering around more air traffic, it took us only about 30 minutes to get over into the Marana approach control area, I called Marana approach and said this is Bonanza 11 Victor, ten north, landing Marana. After a long pause, came the reply, Bonanza 11 Victor, Marana approach, do you have a clearance number? I answered affirmative and relayed my clearance number, and was cleared to tower frequency. After calling the tower we were cleared to land but told to follow the security trucks at the end of the runway to the terminal.

Scar was waiting for us with two more security people. Security was told by Scar to take our plane to Hangar 3 and then we were taken into the building where Scar's wife was waiting to greet us. She was a great gal, went to the U with us and was a Montana champion tennis player in high school. that this was a one night stay and we must leave at first light. I was told that night that Tiger lost his flying edge for the big birds, retired, and was flying for UPS in Tucson and Scar gave me his phone number. At 0700 we launched and headed for Tucson International Airport and hoped for a reunion with Tiger. The mystery with Scar still remained but I was quite sure I knew who he worked for all these years.

We met at the airport cafe and it was great to see Tiger again. He looked a lot older, kind of worn, but the same old smile. We had a good old time, talking about family and different things, finished breakfast, then I said, "Tiger, I monitored you on the school bus when you were in grade school, went to church with you and your family, your sister was my sister's best friend, I vouched for you with Scar, on your big job, and for the past 20 years, and you and Scar could tell me nothing! What in the hell is going on!?" Tiger said, "Let's go outside and talk in private." "Byron, when I got the job with Scar to fly I knew it was a "spook" job, you know Air America, Intermountain Air, CIA and all that good stuff. I can tell you about it now because it has been declassified. Scar won't talk about it because he is still working for the airline. We flew all over Southeast Asia and back and forth to the U.S., hauling people and cargo. Again, I was

just the pilot and was told where to go and what to do, I never did know about who or what I was hauling. I was paid monthly, if I went down nobody knew me or claimed me, I was on my own that way. The money was sent home from a U.S. account. Even my wife knew very little about what I was doing. Don't say too much about this for a while but the whole story will come out soon. My wife is very sick with cancer and won't last long now."

That was the end of the visit as Tiger was scheduled on another flight. Tiger's wife died about a month later and ironically Tiger was killed in an unusual accident about a year later when the nose landing gear on a large airliner malfunctioned while Tiger was working on it?? His family asked me to speak at his funeral. At Tiger's funeral I spoke of his young life, his family, and what I knew about his service to his country and of course a short bit of what I knew about Air America and Intermountain Aviation, the CIA cover airline. There were about six big, young guys, all nicely dressed, and unknown to anybody at the funeral?? During my talk they all sat stoic and expressionless and departed immediately after the service. Nobody knew them!

After the service was over Tiger's two daughters came up to me and said to me as they were crying, "We did not know where Dad was all those years, and Mom said she could not tell us. We knew he flew a lot of planes, but he was

gone so much, few letters, checks were mailed to Mom and when he did come home he looked old and tired. At last we have some closure, know what he was doing, and as you said he and those who worked with him were heroes!" Scar did not attend the funeral!

When I piece this saga all together it is amazing how it rolled around my life. Scar who knew me well, knew I had a Secret Clearance with the military, Montana raised and educated and operating a Montana business, managed security operations in the Air Force, worked with the FBI on several flight operations, and was a commercial pilot. They had me well scoped. I learned Scar was being dropped into China by parachute in covert operations and then walked out, during college years. That is why he was gone from college about one quarter a year and why he could not tell anyone where he had been. Because of my background he arranged for me, with him, to buy Johnson Flying Service, and had the money behind him. I guess I liked the ranch and family too much. Johnson was sold shortly after to Evergreen Aviation, who immediately began to use the air carrier permit to fly people and unknown cargo around the world. It was released 20 years later that Evergreen was part of Air America and a CIA operative? Scar was CEO of Intermountain, one of probably six airlines funded and operated by the SPOOKS.

These were brave men and women,

not unlike many Special Forces units that have unbelievable missions today. For all the people who have answered the call to service in all the wars in my life time, I salute you. Was I a SPOOK? No, but I sure had some good friends who were, and I know I was used, but to good use.

Scar retired and with his wife lives in a small town in mountains in the northwest part of the U.S.

Scar never did tell me anything!

Marana Air Base

Built in 1942 by the Sundt & Del Webb Construction Companies and opened in March 1943, the facility was known as Marana Army Air Field. During World War II, the airfield was under the command of the 389th Army Air Force Base Unit, AAF West Coast Training Center and used as a training base, as part of the 50,000 Pilot Training Program.

Marana conducted basic flight training & the training of transport pilots in instrument flying & navigation, being the home of the 3024th (Pilot School, Basic). Chinese pilots were also trained there. Five satellite airfields were established for Marana during World War II: Picacho Aux #1, Rillito Aux #2 (currently reused as Marana Northwest Regional Airport), Coronado Aux #3, Avra Aux #4, and Sahuaro Aux #5 (currently El Tiro Gliderport).

The infrastructure installed at Marana during World War II was extensive. This included water, sewer, and gas systems that were still used until some problems developed in the 1990s. There was also a massive storm drain system. The airfield also had a railroad spur line & railroad station.

Marana was closed after World War II and in 1948, Pinal County accepted a deed to the property, subsequent to the Air Force's disposal of most of the buildings, waterlines, gas lines, and electrical lines. From 1948-51, Pinal County leased the property to multiple tenants, and from 1951-56, Marana was reused as a contractor-operated USAF flying school, operated by Darr Aeronautical Technical Company.

Marana became the headquarters of all Central Intelligence Agency air operations during the Vietnam War years, when it was the primary facility of Intermountain Airlines, a wholly owned CIA "front" company which was used to supply covert operations in Southeast Asia & elsewhere. Intermountain was infamous for its thinly veiled CIA special ops which included development & use of the Fulton Skyhook, but its cover was its non-scheduled freight & maintenance operations. Marana was the principal

continental United States maintenance base for Southeast Asia CIA operations including Air America and Continental Air Services.

One of the more notable aircraft assigned to Marana during its CIA years was a Boeing B-17G Flying Fortress, AAF Serial 44-85531. 531 was registered September 1957 to Western Enterprises, Inc. of Taiwan (founded by the CIA in 1951). In late 1957 missions were staged from Kurmitola Air Field in East Pakistan (now Bangladesh) to parachute agents into Tibet. The aircraft was disassembled for parts at Clark Air Base, Philippines between March and October 1958, and it is believed that this plane was eventually scrapped. The serial number 44-85531 appeared again as registered on another B-17G, September 1, 1960 registered to Atlantic General Enterprise, Washington DC (another CIA front) as N809Z. These registration numbers were then changed to the true numbers of 44-83785. Based again at Marana, this aircraft later flew black operations over Vietnam and was used to retrieve two American agents from an abandoned Soviet scientific base in the Arctic using the Fulton Skyhook in Operation Coldfeet.
