Montana as of 9/7/17. The Lodgepole Complex fire, southwest of Fort Peck, which is somewhat contained but is still active, has burned over 270,000 acres. The Rice Ridge fire which is in the Lolo National Forest northeast of Seeley Lake, has now burned 108,000 acres and the Lolo Peak fire which is located southeast of the Rice Ridge fire has now burned some 45,000 acres. The Sartin Draw fire, located northeast of Ashland, MT, is at over 100,000 acres, the Brush Flat fire is

ribeye sandwiches for all the farm show to enjoy. Each year a record breaking amount of CHB ribeye sandwiches are sold as a fundraiser for the association.

According to Barclay and Darwin Kreth, SDHA has been involved with Dakotafest since 2003. This year a new record was set with 10,734 sandwiches served. This beat last year's record by 300 sandwiches.

approximately 57,000 acres, the Meyers fire has now encompassed over 54,000 acres. The Sapphire Complex fire has now burned over 42,000 acres, the Sunrise fire has now encompassed 26,000 acres. Montana now has 43 active fires burning throughout the state, a good share of the fires are in western Montana. TV station KYSS reported that there have been over 1,500 fires reported in the state this year which have burned 937 square miles. (See fire maps in other sections of Hereford America, for locations)

It was announced on local TV recently, that Montana is the largest drought stricken state in the nation and most of the area that has been so devastated by drought is in eastern Montana, and this drought continues over into the Dakotas.

This year the forest contained dense fire fuel areas caused by excellent moisture in the past winter, and early spring, and summer rains. Montana got extremely hot for this state, for most of the summer, the temperatures were in the high 80's to mid-90's, accompanied with hot winds. Then with the combination of dry lightning, misuse of recreational vehicles and campfires, causing each of these fires to start and once they were started they have been nearly impossible to put out. Most experts in fire fighting around the state of Montana say that probably only winter with its snow cover will put the fires out.

Many of the smaller towns in western Montana near the fires have been evacuated and the owners are not sure when they can return to their homes. In central Montana, the Lodgepole fire has now consumed 200,000 acres that involved more of the cattle country in Montana. Whereas, in western Montana a big share of the fires are in the dense forest areas, or summer recreational areas.

The ranching industry near the small towns affected by the Lodgepole fire was devastated. The fences had to be cut to allow the cattle to escape the fire. The grasslands and hay fields were not spared. The ranchers in this area have a tough battle ahead of them replacing the cattle that were lost, the fences and the feed that will not return for at least another year.


It is amazing, as in other areas of the United States, how people helped people, in that loads of hay were sent into this area and large amounts of money have been donated to relief funds. The state's budget for fires is now depleted and is causing a series fiscal problem for the state of Montana. The cost of fighting the fires at this point has reached over \$284,000,000 and \$53,000.00 has come out of the state budget. I am reporting on Montana fires, however, all of the western states are having unbelievable numbers of wildfires at this time.

The awful flooding situation in Texas is also a terrible disaster and it seems like with all the fires in the western United States, the flooding in Texas and the


flooding that could occur from the next hurricane in Florida, have made this a disaster-prone year. We hope that all the people hurt in these disasters can start to heal up in these next months and years.

It has been extremely dry in Montana, Idaho and North and South Dakota and reports from as far east as Iowa indicate the same conditions. It does concern all of us in the cattle industry what all of these events will mean to the future of our industry, we can only hope that the marketing of our commercial cattle will hold on a level that will allow our commercial producers to survive. We had a huge over supply of black bulls being marketed this last year and that had some effect on the marketing of Hereford bulls, so it will be very





Andrew is a beloved son, brother, and husband-to-be who will be deeply missed.





The last stop of the day was at Frederickson Ranch west of Spearfish.

The Fredericksons are a third generation Hereford ranch that started in west-central Minnesota. The ranch is operated by Mark and Mary Kay Frederickson along with their son Nate and his wife Jayna and their children, Teegan and Tiernan. Nate's sister Sarah and her husband Shawn Tatman and their daughter Peyton live in Sheridan, WY. They still maintain involvement in the ranch.

In 2002 Nate moved from Minnesota to western South Dakota to pursue a career in the animal health industry. Realizing the area would be a great place to raise cattle, the rest of the family eventually pulled up stakes and found a ranch near Spearfish. Nate retired from the animal health business in 2015 to devote his time to the ranch.

Fredericksons currently run 450-500 cows comprised of one-third Herefords, Angus and commercial cattle. They market their bulls through a private LLC called Pyramid Beef which was formed 7 years ago. This year's sale will be in December at the ranch in a newly built bull development and sale facility.

The tour group enjoyed the large displays of cows at Fredericksons along with several smaller groups and a select group from Cody and Shawna Chabot even though it was damp and foggy. A delicious meal of CHB tri-tip was served and made for a very enjoyable evening.

On the second day of the tour the group headed north. The two and a half hour drive through an area of rolling hills and plains took them to Carmichael Herefords.

Carmichael Herefords is now in their fifth generation with recent additions of grandchildren James Justin (JJ) Schaefers and Evan Jess Carmichael. In the early 1940s Pete and Garnet Carmichael moved their family and their Herefords from Gregory County, SD to Perkins County on Thunder Butte Creek. In the late 1950s their son James and his wife Dorothy started a registered Hereford herd with heifers purchased from Thorpes of Britton, SD and Franklin Nash of Colorado. Through the 1970s bloodlines were mostly Prince Domino and Cruziero. After that Line One bloodlines from Cooper and Holden were added and became the predominant lines.

In the early years bulls were sold private treaty to neighbors and friends. Annual production sales began around 1970 with the 48th sale in spring of 2017. The sale is at the ranch on the third Saturday in February.

Keith and his brother Bryan, sons of James and Dorothy, currently manage the ranch. Bryan operates the original ranch and Keith operates the ranch that was owned by their mother's folks, the Hartmans. The cows are run separately. Keith's three children are also involved with Riley and wife Roni running commercial Herefords, Brittany and her husband Jake run registered Herefords and Brice is predominantly interested in the registered herd and helps with the day-to-day operations of the ranch with Keith.

Carmichael Ranch also markets first-cross baldies every third Monday in October each year along with several of their customers at Faith Livestock.

Cattle were also on display from Weishaar Herefords Lemmon, SD; Longwood Herefords, Lemmon, SD; Hermann Ranch, Lemmon, SD; and Tenold Ranch and Brian Glass, Reva, SD.

After the Carmichael tour stop the group proceeded south to Hawks Herefords by Howes.

Ed Hawk's dad started the ranch with commercial cattle and the first registered Herefords arrived in 1958. In 1974, they added some land and purchased two loads of cows from Robert Meeks, Dalhart, TX, and have been running over two hundred head since. In the year 2000 Hawks started adding some polled breeding through artificial insemination. Half of the herd bulls originate from those matings and they purchased the others. Currently, they have sires from Feddes Herefords, Jack and Bev Beeson and Ace Diemert.
