

Bayers, Schafer AHA Hall of Fame Inductees

Lester Schafer, Buffalo Lake, MN, and Byron Bayers, Twin Bridges, MT, were inducted into the Hereford Hall of Fame Oct. 27, in Kansas City, MO, during the American Hereford Association (AHA) Hereford Honorees Reception during the AHA Annual Meeting and Conference.

The Hall of Fame honor annually recognizes breeders who have dynamically influenced the direction and advancement of the Hereford breed.

Schafer was raised on the farm where

he currently resides. The registered Hereford herd Schafer runs was originally started by his aunt and uncle in 1917. The farm received century farm status in 2000. He purchased a scale and began collecting weaning weights on calves in 1960. When the AHA established the Whole Herd Total Performance Records (TPRTM) program a few years later, Schafer was one of the first to sign up.

Throughout the years, he has remained active in the Minnesota Here-

ford Association, Minnesota Hereford Breeders and the Minnesota State Cattlemen's Association. Schafer served as the secretary for the Minnesota Hereford Association for 25 years and has been inducted into the Minnesota Hereford Breeders Hall of Fame and the Minnesota Livestock Hall of Fame. Schafer also received the Century Breeder award for 100 years in the Hereford business at the Hereford Honorees Reception.

Bayers runs Bayers Hereford Ranch,

the oldest continuous running Hereford herd in the state of Montana. After graduating from the University of Montana in 1952, Bayers served as an officer in the United States Air Force before returning to the ranch in 1955.

He served as president of the Montana Hereford Association in 1958, 1960 and 1970, and was elected president of the AHA in 1976. In the 1960s and early 1970s, he judged at almost

(continued from page 1) are very accomplished, in fact they are so good that they sang the Star Spangled Banner at one of our major colleges this year, sang God Bless America. All of us then pledged Allegiance to the Flag, and after that, several members of the students and staff read patriotic poems about Veterans.

At the end all of the kids sang a song to us. As these festivities were occurring, I couldn't help but notice how this was affecting so many of the Veterans. Tears were dripping down the faces of many

of us guys, who had lost close friends in the various wars in which they served.

When I went to college just before the Korean War, I was put in a room at the dormitory with eight different freshmen, one who became a good friend of mine and probably one of the closer friends that I had in college, by the name of Jerry Wright from Salmon, Idaho.

He had come from a logging family and they were the kind of people that really knew how to work hard. His ambition was to go to college and get a degree in Forestry and then go home and work in the forestry industry in Idaho. At that time all of us had to make the decision as to whether to go in to the ROTC program or to take a chance on being drafted before our college days were done.

We had a lot of World War Two veterans around us in college and most of them gave us younger guys advice to get into the service area that you would like. Jerry and I signed up for four years of training in the ROTC program, I chose the Air Force, but Jerry chose the Army unit, because he felt like his experience on the ground would be much more to his abilities than possibly flying in the Air Force.

Upon graduation I was sent to San

Antonio, Texas and Jerry was sent to Fort Ord, California. We were so busy we did not communicate with each other during our service days but in my second year in the Air Force I got thinking about Jerry and I thought I should try to contact him. I wrote a letter to his Salmon, ID address, but it came back unclaimed. I knew his brother, who also lived in the Salmon ID area, so I wrote to him and told him I was wondering about Jerry, because the letter I had sent to Jerry was returned. I heard back from Jerry's brother within a month notifying me that First Lieutenant Jerry Wright had been killed in action in Korea, on a major assault by the American army, ascending a mountain in Korea in 1953.

That is about the same time that I was notified of a young rancher friend of mine, that lived about three miles from us, that had been killed at sea. We Veterans that are still alive and were able to return home from the Military were the lucky ones. Veteran's Day honors all of us Veterans but we really honor the most, those who did not come home. The kids and school did a nice job of honoring us at our school, but we all felt saddened that day as we left the school, because of the memories of our fallen friends.


The AHA announced the BOLT this week. Several things were unfortunate in that the computer glitch that occurred the day of the announcement kept everybody in wonderment about what had happened. In the next several days as those glitches were corrected you could start to make more sense in some of the results.

While I was in Kansas City for the AHA convention, I sat in on a seminar where a major discussion was held on the BOLT activities that would basically change all the EPD data as we knew it. I have only been able to search data on 50 head or so, but the data in most cases shows major changes in some of the EPDs.

This is a major change for the industry because people have worked for so many years on getting their cattle with the EPDs that were advantageous to the operation, and the breeders, for breeding and selling the cattle. Then came along the "50K test" which was proclaimed to be something of the future to foresee what our cattle would be at a younger stage in their life, or it would solidify the data on older cattle that we were using.

Most breeders throughout the industry, I believe, felt like this system was getting pretty solidified and it was something they could go on with. Now BOLT has created a new technology introduction into the Hereford breed for our EPD system.

Many people with the right animal will prosper and many people who thought they had the right animals, but whose EPDs fell dramatically, will obviously be hurt. Some people are worried

I was advised in a call from Jack Ward a few weeks earlier that I was to be inducted in the Hereford Hall of Fame, at the Hereford Convention, and we were now on our way. 




Final Farewell

beef. They are a complete team and do a better job than any other packer I have ever worked with to satisfy customers. Integrity, at a level of 100%, is evident in everything they do."

Alex recounts a few of his notable success stories. "I called on a local restaurant called The Parker House. Andy Cook is the owner and chef. I showed the Hereford product, he loved it and started using all Classic Hereford in his restaurant. His former meat sales person tried to salvage the business with five different labels offered, including USDA Prime. They cooked around 20 different cuts and offered the meat at a blind cutting." Alex said everyone in the room, including the competitor, chose the Hereford steaks as the favorite.



Country Meat Market, Brookhaven, MS, switched from using IBP beef to Greater Omaha's Classic Hereford Beef.

Dar Fresh is an innovative packaging that allows cut steaks to age in the package, refrigerated at 36 degrees or less for up to 30-45 days. This is used for export customers and now for foodservice and retail as well.

This innovation for the "value-added cut steaks" is awesome, according to Alex. Steve Dear, manager of the Value-Added Facility, says the Dar Fresh packaging further extends the fresh shelf life beyond regular packing. The product continues to age in the packaging. This is very beneficial to retail and food service.

"When dealing with smaller cut shops, the integrity level just isn't there," said Alex, "I trust everything I get from Greater Omaha, and know I can count on the quality and consisten-



Schultz Elected AHA President, Atkins Vice President

KANSAS CITY, MO — Kevin Schultz, Haviland, KS, was announced as the new president of the American Hereford Association (AHA) during the Annual Meeting and Conference Oct. 28 in Kansas City, MO.

Schultz, along with his wife Vera, owns and operates Sandhill Farms, Haviland, KS. Sandhill Farms is a seven-generation, diversified farming and cattle operation with 300 cows.

The family has fed out its steers at commercial feedlots for the past 15-20 years. Feedlot performance data, as well as individual carcass data, have been collected and tracked.

The Schultz family also sells commercial open heifers and customerowned black baldie heifers each year in the sale. Sandhill genetics have been part of the National Reference Sire Program (NRSP) and the Circle A Ranch heterosis project. Schultz uses these programs to increase the accuracy and predictability of his bulls and to identify outliers that will help move the breed in the desired direction. Sandhill Farms is a Gold TPRTM (Total Performance Record) Breeder; the family has been whole-herd reporting since the beginning of its registered cattle program.

"Transparency is vitally important for the success of the members, the Association, board and staff," Schultz said. "I want to continue with open communication of goals and ideas between the Association and the members. I also want to support the staff in implementing the programs that have been initiated, such as the new genetic evaluation and indexes and the new ideas and programs that will be used to implement the strategic plan."

Atkins selected vice president

Selected to serve as the 2018 vice president was Pete Atkins, Tea, SD. Atkins and his wife, Laura, and three sons, Scott, Craig and Paul, own and operate Atkins Herefords, Tea, SD.

Pete was raised on a diversified cattle, hog and crop farming operation in southeastern South Dakota, where he and his wife live today. The Atkins family started collecting and reporting performance data in 1975 and have used artificial insemination (AI) since the late 1970s and embryo transfer (ET) for the past nine years.

Atkins Herefords' goal is to produce high-performing cattle with moderate birth weights that have eye appeal and will work for the commercial cattleman. Emphasis is placed on raising sound, trouble-free cattle, and udder quality in the cow herd is stressed heavily. Pete thinks it is important to use a balance of all tools available when selecting breeding stock.

Today, Atkins Herefords consists of a base herd of 25 registered cows, and it produces an additional 20 to 50 ET calves each year. Together with their good friends and partners, the Jerry

Delaney family, the Atkins' market bulls through a bull sale each year, and every other year they market females through a fall production sale. Atkins Herefords consigns bulls and females to the Mile High Night Sale and exhibits carloads of bulls and pens of heifers with the Delaneys each year in Denver.

Directors elected

Delegates elected three new directors during the membership meeting. Nate Frederickson, Spearfish, SD; Mark St. Pierre, El Nido, CA; and Joe Waggoner, Carthage, MS, will serve four-year terms on the 12-member Board. Completing their terms on the AHA Board were outgoing president Terri Barber, Channing, TX; Dave Bielema, Ada, MI.; and Joe Van Newkirk, Oshkosh, NE.

Nate Frederickson

Cattleman Nate Frederickson, Spearfish, SD, is co-owner and operator of Frederickson Ranch in the Northern Black Hills of South Dakota.

Nate, along with his wife, Jayna, two young sons, Teegan and Tiernan, and his parents, Mark and Mary Kay, run 450-500 head of registered Hereford, Angus and commercial cows, which are used in their ET program.

Frederickson Ranch markets bulls through a private limited liability company called Pyramid Beef, which was created seven years ago as a marketing outlet for the ranch's bulls and commercial females. Pyramid Beef has two outside partners and markets 150 bulls a year through the annual production sale, hosted at the bull development center on the ranch.

Frederickson Ranch strives to provide its customers efficient, low-maintenance genetics along with exceptional customer service and avenues to help them add value to their bottom line.

Prior to ranching full-time, Nate spent 14 years in the animal health industry working with veterinarians, distribution companies, feedlots and cowcalf operations.

Nate is currently serving on the board of directors for the South Dakota Hereford Association and is a member of Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Spearfish.

Mark St. Pierre

Mark St. Pierre is the beef manager at Pedretti Ranches in El Nido, CA. He is a member of the Pedretti family, and has worked in the family business for 36 years.

At Pedretti Ranches, Mark manages the Hereford herd, which consists of 200 registered cows with 100 calving in the spring and 100 calving in the fall.

The Pedrettis have long emphasized performance data in their Hereford herd with performance records dating back to the 1950s. While the ranch received recognition in the showring in the '70s and early '80s, including cattle shown on the Hill and in the carloads at the NWSS, the Pedrettis' goal has always been to produce cattle that work for the commercial cattlemen in California. Pedretti Ranches raises approximately 80 bulls each year, which are marketed by private treaty sales. With two calving seasons six months apart, the ranch always has the next set of bulls on test. Both Mark and his father-in-law, Gino Pedretti, work with commercial customers. Pedretti Ranches focuses on sound cattle with balance EPDs, good disposition and udder quality.

Mark manages the day-to-day work including addressing herd health issues, vaccination schedules, feeding, pasture management, breeding and calving. He also works in the farming operation, which involves growing cotton, corn and hay, and has some limited duty on the family dairy.

Mark has served as a California-Nevada Hereford Association board member and has hosted numerous tours. He has been a Merced-Mariposa County Cattlemen's Association director, a member of the Chowchilla High School FFA ag advisory committee, a 4-H leader and a volunteer fireman. Mark has also served as a deacon and elder in his local church.

Mark and his wife, Kim, have two children — a daughter, Christy, and a son, Matt, and his wife, Leah — and one granddaughter.


Joe Waggoner

American Hereford Association Releases BOLT Genetic Evaluation

Dec. 7, 2017, KANSAS CITY - The American Hereford Association (AHA) released the first updated expected progeny differences (EPDs) and corresponding accuracies using the Biometric Open Language Tools (BOLT) genetic evaluation software Dec. 4. The new genetic evaluation also includes two new traits, Sustained Cow Fertility (SCF) and Dry Matter Intake (DMI), and updated profit (\$) indexes.

"It's long been our goal to provide Hereford breeders the most advanced and reliable genetic evaluation possible," says AHA President Kevin Schultz. "This new genetic evaluation gives us one of the best tools to identify breed-leading genetics at a faster pace than ever before."

Due to the industry-leading Whole Herd Total Performance Records (TPRTM) program, in its 17th year, and the current 53,000 Hereford genotypes on record, the AHA is poised for a stronghold in the DNA era, making Hereford cattle even more predictable.

Last year the Association pursued a genetic evaluation overhaul to allow for better use of genomics in its evaluation.

"BOLT provides a more robust eval-

uation by calculating true accuracy on animals," says AHA Chief Operating Officer and Director of Breed Improvement Shane Bedwell.

Utilizing BOLT, all factors associated with contemporary group makeup will be accounted for in the calculation of true accuracy. This genetic evaluation system moves away from a full multitrait model, decoupling models to better estimate traits of interest. It also modifies contemporary group structure to allow for as much data as possible to affect the evaluation.

In addition, BOLT utilizes a cutoff strategy which only includes animals born after 2001 and animals related by three generations of pedigree.

"A genetic evaluation backed solely by Whole Herd TPR data strengthens the evaluation and takes out selection bias that occurred pre-Whole Herd TPR," Bedwell says.

Hereford breeder Jack Holden, Valier, MT, was a member of the advisory committee, comprised of cattlemen and the scientific community, who was tasked with reviewing the new genetic evalu-

"The process of generating the new

genetic evaluation was really outstanding, and I feel comfortable with where we're at now," Holden says. "BOLT will give us better, more accurate indications of genetic potential in our animals. Any time we can identify that quicker, along with finding cattle that fit phenotypically, we can make faster genetic progress to improve our herd."

New traits and updated \$Indexes

Released with the new genetic evaluation are two new traits: SCF and DMI. The AHA's new SCF EPD is a prediction of a cow's ability to continue to calve from three years of age through 12 years of age, given she calved as a two-year-old. The EPD is expressed as a deviation in the proportion of the ten-possible calvings to 12 years old expressed as a probability.

"The new SCF EPD is a powerful tool," Schultz says. "In a commercial cow herd, longevity and fertility are profit drivers. We're providing a new tool for that purpose.'

Feed intake records from AHA research projects and breeder data collection have been analyzed in a genetic evaluation to predict DMI EPDs. Reported in pounds of feed consumed per day, this EPD characterizes genetics for intake, with a lower numeric value being associated with less feed consumed on a dry matter basis.

SCF and DMI will now be included in the AHA \$Indexes, along with other economically relevant traits (ERTs), including carcass weight (CW) and mature cow weight (MCW).

DMI and CW will be included in all three AHA \$Indexes to help predict the cost associated with feed inputs and measure the end-product pounds that are critical for profit.

SCF will replace scrotal circumference as the predictor of fertility and be a large contributor to both maternal indexes," Bedwell says. "Adding these ERTs into the profit indexes will provide a more robust and comprehensive selection tool for commercial producers to select Hereford bulls to be used on Angus based cows.'

EPDs will be released once a week, an increase in frequency from the previous 10 times a year.




