I feel as though this is an interesting end to a crazy year and half. At least prices at most Hereford production sales have been strong in 2021.

It certainly looks like the governor of Colorado, underestimated the popularity of beef and the strength of ranchers in his state. In early March, Governor Polis declared March 20th as a meat-out day in the state of Colorado.

Ranchers in Colorado and other states quickly responded, in large numbers, declaring it an "Eat Beef" day which eventually turned into an eat meat day which was heavily promoted in a number of states with resounding success.

"I think this is a wake-up call," said Terry Fankhauser, executive vice president of Colorado Cattlemen's Association (CCA), which launched the Meat In Movement in response to the gubernatorial proclamation.

"On this day, CCA encourages Colorado to meet in a restaurant and order your favorite meat dish, meet your family and friends for a meal featuring meat!"

"The goal of this day is to not only promote the benefits of meat consumption to Colorado, but to also patronize our local businesses, restaurants, etc. that have been deeply affected by the economic struggles of the pandemic. CCA is working with multiple groups to promote meat products through discounts, specials, and more! As we approach



euben Hovland picked out the place on Plum Creek, seven miles east of Milesville, SD, in the mid-forties. The previous owner had pieced the place together from various homesteaders who couldn't survive the harsh climate, but then lost it to Rural Credit in the 'dirty thirties.' Reuben's parents Severin and Martha (Erstad) Hovland were Norwegian immigrants who lived in Minnesota for a while before home-


steading near Nolan, east of Phillip, SD, where Reuben was born. Severin passed away in a runaway accident when Reuben was young, but the big family pulled together and kept going in spite of the tragedy.

Reuben completed grade school, took a break before going through high school, then attended the School of Mines for a year, and worked at mining jobs in the Black Hills for several years.

"When Dad bought this place there

was just a log house and a log barn and one framed shed here," Allen Hovland recalled.

13 cows.

Shortly after getting settled on the ranch, Reuben married a young school-teacher, Rue Adene Kulvik. Their son, Allen, grew up on the ranch, and his son Miles and wife Erin are now raising their four children, Connor, Mackenzie, Eli and Miley in the picturesque hills along with Herefords that trace back to some of the original registered stock that Reuben invested in.

"Herefords were in their heyday back then," said Miles Hovland. "Pretty much all of the cows on the place trace back to 13 cows that my grandpa bought in the fifties."

"Dad started selling bulls in the middle to later sixties," Allen said. "I recall one year when we took them to the sale barn at Wall, SD. When I got done

with school and out of the army around 1970, dad built a building here and sold about a hundred bulls every year for a while. I bought some cows when I got out of college, and then bought some more at dad's dispersal."

Through the years, the family has been loyal to the Herefords that helped them get the place established. Allen has kept a focus on a good old-fashioned range cow and stayed with horned genetics as much as possible.

Hovlands still sell bulls, though not on a large scale. Select bull calves are offered private treaty at the ranch right off the cow in November and December.

"Whatever we don't get sold by about the tenth of December get a band put on them and sell with the rest of the Hereford steer calves in January or February," Miles said. "Dad sold two year old bulls until the mid 'eighties, but you get a lot into them and if you don't get them all sold then you're stuck. We don't try really hard to market a lot of bulls; we mostly sell local although we sold some over by Mitchell this year and we have customers from Hermosa who have been coming back for quite a few years. Most of the bulls go on black cows to produce baldy calves."

Heifers and three year old cows start calving mid February.

"We run our three year olds coming with their second calf separately from the older cows so we can take a little better care of them," Miles said. We breed them to calve with the heifers again, and that gives them a little extra time to recover. That way they have an extra cycle before we breed them back in the summer. It seems to help with breed up for that age group."

Older cows are bred to calve starting March 20th. About half of the herd is bred black to capitalize on the hybrid vigor; baldie calves are marketed in Ft. Pierre mid-October.

"A lot of the baldy heifers end up sticking around the country," Miles

said. "People make cows out of them. Most of our Hereford heifers are kept for replacements to maintain our own cow herd."

Hardiness, vigor and docility are high priority.

"We expect a cow to calve (cont. on page 4)



and take care of her calf," Allen said. "A cow needs to be smart enough to calve in the right place where there's protection on Plum Creek, or to calve during a lull in a storm and get her calf up and sucking. I guess I'm old fashioned, but I like to have a lot of vigor in them. A good mother will get her calf up and get his belly full. The key is to sell those drys. Of course, we check on them, and if we need to we bring a calf in and warm him up, but if it doesn't work, sell the cow!"

Hovlands use quite a few home raised bulls, AI'ing on occasion to bring in new blood. Ranch work is a family affair, and Allen enjoys having his grandchildren working alongside him. Cattle are handled horseback, and while a side-by-side was added a few years ago to help with fencing and other chores, there has never been a four-wheeler on the ranch.

"My two oldest kids are getting old enough to be quite a bit of help---when they want to be," Miles laughed. "Erin is around all the time helping too. I like the variety we get to experience throughout the year, but I really enjoy fall. There's maybe not quite so much to worry about; you never know in this country what the weather is going to hand you. I grew up with Herefords, so I guess maybe I don't know any better, but it's pretty neat to be able to look at the papers and trace these cows back to my grandpa's herd."

this day, we will be posting a full listing of businesses and restaurants to show your support to on this."

Almost half of the state's counties supported the Meat-In movement with many restaurants following suit and running specials on beef and other meat items.

All of the commotion seems to have brought out a number of former ranchers and other people who support ranching even though they aren't involved in the business.

The move has also spurred a beef production legacy program within the state of Colorado along with an effort to feed hungry children in Colorado. Of course all of these are supported by fund raisers.

Governor Mark Gordon of neighboring state, Wyoming, declared March 20th as Hearty Meat Day. "I stand by our ranchers and farmers, who feed the world and help manage our natural resources," said Gordon. He also invited Governor Polis and other Coloradans to join Wyoming in their celebration of meat. Ah yes, the gubenatorial stick in the eye.

Not to be outdone, big beef state Nebraska's Governor Pete Ricketts declared March 20th "Meat on the Menu Day," saying "it's important to push back against the anti-science, antiagricultural radical activists like PETA that are pushing this meat-out agenda."







Hereford Demand: Commercial producers seeking hybrid vigor turn to Hereford bulls

Spring seedstock sales are well under way in many parts of the country as cattlemen and women purchase bulls meant to add value to their operations. An increasing number are choosing Hereford.

"We've found that a lot of our customers that have more straightbred cattle, once they use Hereford genetics in a crossbreeding rotation, not only did they see higher weaning weights at the sale yard and their calves were more in demand, but more importantly, we feel that the

female end of things has improved from a fertility standpoint, and maternal traits have improved a lot when they've actually used Hereford genetics in a crossbreeding rotation," says Kyle Colyer, Idaho Hereford breeder.

Colyer says the breed's proven longevity and efficiency have more commercial cattle operations turning to Hereford.


"One of the main reasons they come back to Hereford bulls, year in and year out, is the longevity and how long those bulls last, the structural correctness and the feet and legs, and how many years they can get out of a bull," he adds.

Hereford bulls used on Angusbased cows offer cattlemen advantages in profitability, herd size, retained female fertility and longevity, according to multi-year studies from the American Hereford Association (AHA) and leading commercial cattle ranches.

Shane Bedwell, AHA chief operating officer and director of breed improvement, says heterosis study results released in recent years show a \$51 per-cow, per-year advantage. (Read more at hereford.org/commercial/.)

"With direct heterosis, by using Hereford genetics on that British cow herd, you're going to get about a 15-to 20-pound increase," Bedwell says, compared to straight commercial Angus cattle. One study, in which 600 commercial Angus females were AI-bred to 10 Hereford sires, documented improved feed efficiency and average daily gain (ADG) among black baldie calves — as well as fertility increases in females.

"They kept the baldy females back, bred them and compared them over



a three-year study, and that showed a 7% advantage in pregnancy rate, so we're getting more females bred because of that heterosis advantage," he says.

The advantages also translate to the feedyard.

"We've always had that great, rich tradition of Hereford cattle being docile and sound, and now we've coupled that together with calving ease bulls that can inject a lot of pounds into your calf crop. The conversion advantage of Hereford cattle is tremendous, and we've also seen the end product come with that as well."

With the breed's genetic progress in recent years, Colyer recommends commercial ranchers consider upgrading their bull batteries when possible. "It's important for producers to update their bull batteries to get the most current genetics that are available to them, especially the carcass genetics that the Hereford breed has been able to turn over and find most recently, especially more IMF and adding more marbling into these cattle," he suggests. "We feel that if commercial producers were updating their bull batteries more often, that would be a good thing."
