It is ironic that the 11 year anniversary of the Atlas blizzard which devastated ranchers in western South Dakota, southwest North Dakota, eastern Wyoming and western Nebraska, October 4-5, was about the same time hurricane Helene hit the southeastern states. Those of us who went through Atlas certainly remember it and the devastation it unleashed on our area killing thousands of cattle, horses and sheep.

Mother Nature didn't leave out the western states the week Helene hit. Yet another huge fire started in Wyoming and is still burning as is the Remington fire. These fires along with several others have consumed over 100,000 acres.

North Dakota's large fires — Ray/Alamo and Tioga in Williams County burned over 88,000 acres and is finally contained. Two "smaller" fires, Bear Den Fire and Elkhorn Fire, have burned 11,746

Stellpflug Cattle Company: For the Love of Business and Cattle

Winding through the hills south of Guernsey, WY towards the headquarters of the Stellpflug Cattle Company (SCC), you will be hit with an over-

old and new, the work being done by Andy and Theresa Stellpflug, and the entire SCC crew, is the culmination of generations of wisdom that Andy has gathered from his own father, Glen, and other producers across the country. Furthermore, the Stellpflug's journey to

children and beyond.

Persevere Through It All...

Three generations back, the Stellpflugs moved from Wisconsin and began ranching in Wyoming. Andy's grandfather, born in 1890, worked at the rock quarry in Guernsey to supplement his cattle business, and like many have experienced in the livestock industry, there were years where challenges they faced seemed too great to conquer; however, his grandfather's love for cattle is what helped him persevere through every one.

For example, Andy relayed that early in his grandfather's herd building, he only had one bull, and unfortunately, it died.

"He couldn't afford to buy another one, and it about sunk the place," he said.

But it's in the nature of the Stellpflugs to understand that challenges are a natural part of



whelming sense of reverence as you travel alongside the Oregon Trail, and the historic Register Cliff site where emigrants along the trail inscribed their names in the soft limestone as they made their harrowing trek west. Those individuals were courageous, betting on nothing but themselves as they left what was comfortable in hopes of finding prosperity.

Just a few miles past Register Cliff, newly erected red barns and shops rise from the landscape; though this would seem like an obvious juxtaposition of

"When my grandpa told my grandma about the bull, he just said, 'Whenever tragedy happens, it's no laughing matter, but it don't matter if you laugh,'" Andy recalled fondly.

a similar path of working a labor-intensive job in town, and despite the advice of some other family members, he committed to keeping the ranch going.

“My uncle told him he’d starve death if he stayed, and my dad said, ‘we’ll see about that.’”

A time or two, Glen’s uncle was nearly right, like when a bad turn of the market caused him to lose \$50,000 on a set of yearlings – which was a note that took 18 years to repay. But, he was “business minded” and always managed to make it through.

Looking back, Andy credits his success in all of his business ventures, from starting and operating one of the most successful Renewal by Andersen window businesses in the entire country that currently employs over 160 people, to the tremendous herd expansion being done at SCC today. One experience in particular stuck out to Andy as being a pivotal moment in his development as a businessman.

“When I was 14, dad sent me to Chugwater to buy some bulls, and he told me to sort through and pick the two best bulls, and to not spend more than \$2,000 on each,” Andy said, adding that he was so proud when he got the deal done and his dad was pleased with the result.

That same year, Glen sent Andy to negotiate a deal on some sheep, and the next year on hay.

“He really engrained in me the business side of things,” Andy recalled.

In fact, most people who have worked with Andy will admit that he is a fierce negotiator. Jason Hoffman of the storied Hoffman Ranch in Thedford, NE, identifies with that sentiment as he has developed a strong working relationship with the Stellpflugs in the past few years.

The first time the two met, “Andy came out and they bought four Hereford bulls and one horse – we weren’t planning to sell the horse, but he was pretty persistent about it,” Hoffman laughed.

Since that day, the Stellpflugs have invested in industry-leading females and bulls from the Hoffmans, and have also started selling bulls in the Hoffman sale. Jason has also been a mentor of sorts in Andy’s endeavor to grow SCC.

“He’s a really quick study and figures out things really fast,” Hoffman commended. “He has got unbelievable energy, and he’s very strong in his faith, there’s no doubting that.”

Because of his willingness to learn, Hoffman added that the growth that SCC has in mind is a “natural fit.”

Revisiting those times negotiating deals for his dad, Andy said it wasn’t until he started his Renewal by Andersen business at the age of 28 that he

realized what his dad had been doing.

“I learned that my dad used to make a trip down to Chugwater before me, and he would sort through those bulls first and set that price before I even went there,” he said, pausing to regain his composure, “he brokered every deal before me,” assuring that Andy would gain confidence in a controlled environment.

“I wouldn’t be who I am today without him,” he said proudly.

When Business Meets People...

“My husband is an entrepreneur at heart,” Theresa said as she and Andy reflected on their business ventures over the years since getting married out of high school.

While the pair has always been involved in the family’s commercial cattle business, Andy admitted that “just like most ranchers, I’ve always had like three jobs.”

That included time on the railroad in Guernsey, running an electrical company with about 25 employees, investing in a window blind company, constructing commercial buildings, and of course, their Casper-based Renewal by Andersen window business that has been wildly successful since the beginning, which Andy argues has come in part from the way they treat their customers, and the way they treat their employees; that’s a mentality that has carried into building SCC into a competitive seedstock operation.

“People can buy bulls anywhere, but your customer service is what sets you apart,” he said.

In order to achieve that at the ranch, the Stellpflugs employ a tight-knit group of hard-working people who share their family values and, most importantly, their faith. With seven kids of their own, Andy and Theresa are proud that each one, no matter the age, can go out on the ranch and have positive experiences with any hand.

“People can buy bulls anywhere, but your customer service is what sets you apart,” he said.

Best of All Worlds...

In building highly competitive registered Angus and Hereford herds, the Stellpflugs are not only investing in outstanding sires from reputable operations across the U.S., but they’re using extensive embryo transfer technology to move their genetics forward in a hurry. This process started in 2021 when they purchased the Hoffman’s entire Angus

and Hereford replacement heifer herds, and in the spring of 2022, the Stellpflugs bought their entire donor herd. These acquisitions gave them the opportunity to put in nearly 800 embryos into their registered and commercial recip programs in 2023, Andy explained.

Pouring significant time and energy into their female development all comes down to Glen’s mentality that “the more I know about cattle, the more I realize they’re a lot like people [...] because a woman will make or break you.”

On the bull side, Andy firmly believes that outliers are out there, which is to

say animals that have the numbers, the phenotype, and the disposition.

“Sometimes I think, if their numbers are so great, why doesn’t the bull look good?” Andy said. “Number one, you’re going to have to look at them. Number two, you’re going to have to work them. Docility is a staple for us.”

Long Teton 107 is the perfect example of these priorities. Owned in partnership with Long Angus Ranch, Teton combines mind-boggling growth numbers (WW +106 and YW +181), “feet like a Hereford,” and a quiet disposition. With each of those factors,

In fact, Thomas County boasts EPDs that are in the top 10 percent of the breed in over half of the measured categories.

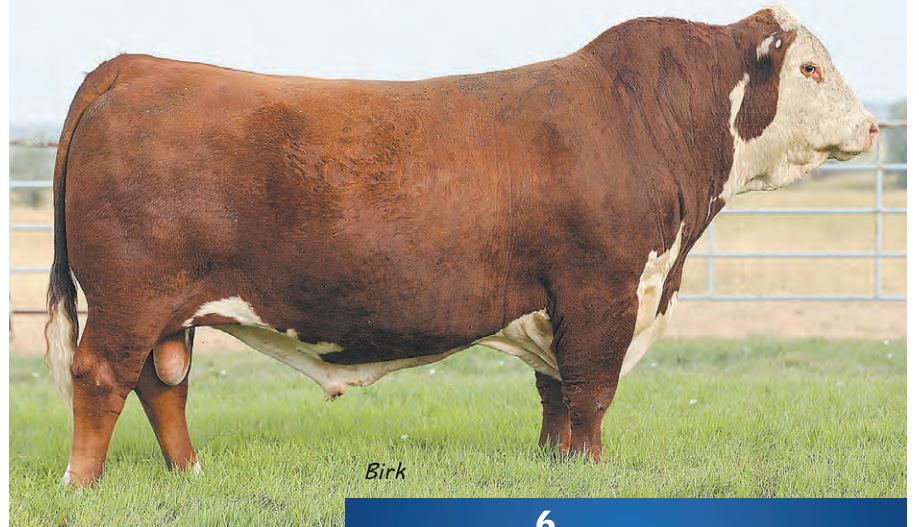

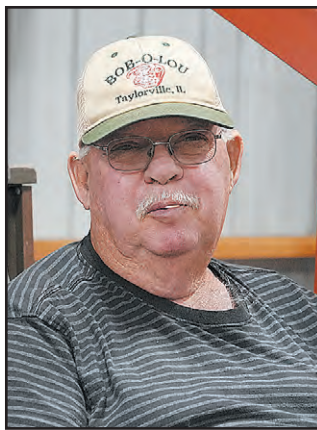

acres (75% contained) and 10,313 (75% contained) respectively, as of 10/14.

Severe drought conditions and high winds were contributing factors to these fires and it remains dry. We are hoping for rain soon. (Note: An early snowin Wyoming has helped extinguish the fires.)

The devastation left by hurricane Helene is unfathomable, especially in North Carolina. Many of the relief efforts, search and rescue have been handled by private citizens who band together to find and help people. From the guys with the mules to people hauling in hay and water to livestock, to the helicopter pilots who've operated search and rescue or carried supplies and StarLink in, Samaritan's purse whose headquarters are in North Carolina, National Guard...they are making a huge difference for people who are suffering and in need.

American people, especially in rural areas, are incredibly resilient and tough. Sometimes it takes disasters like these to pull people together.

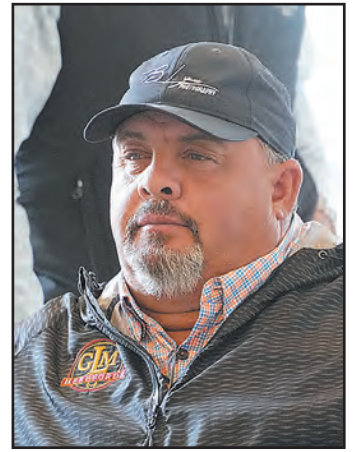

Byron's Classics

On October 9th the strong wind from the north started to blow. The local TV guru warned us that this may be a bad one but mostly you kind of take them so-so on accuracy, but we did

drain the sprinkler system and re-check all the equipment for antifreeze.

We thought about moving the cows from the hay field because they have no shelter there, but didn't do so. I woke up about 3:00AM on the 10th because I could hear the wind buffeting the house and looked out to see a full scale blizzard occurring. The wind was about 40 mph and the snow was moving horizontally, the visibility was about 50 yards at the most. Within a couple of hours we were snowed in and the roads blocked. A Hispanic worker from a nearby ranch got stranded and wandered into our yard during the storm. He could speak very little English and I can speak no Spanish so we had quite a time. We fed him and gave him the warmth of our house for about four hours and then thought he could make it to a ranch house where a friend lived. But he could and did, say "thank you" in English as he departed.

During this time it was impossible to have any idea how the cattle were fairing! This continued for two and one half days, and the drifts continued to build, reaching up to seven feet high. Early on the morning of the third day the Sheriff's Department called to tell me that our cows were walking down the highway. Because no one was traveling for three days, I figured things must be improving.

I phoned some of my helpers and we got the cows back in their pasture. I can't do too much yet because of my recent stroke, so needed to rely on my good helpers, Jeff and Tressy. Two more days passed and we had things under control and everybody, including the neighbors, plowed out. The cows were fine, just a bit chilly and puzzled by this change in weather. We were really lucky that the temperature did not fall during this period. In my lifetime living here I have only seen two or three blizzards so bad, those having temperatures into the 40 below range. Two days later we were back into the +40 degree range again. Just another phenomenon in Montana!

A friend of mine who has close ties to the Angus industry has advised me of a terrible genetic problem that has hit that breed. He advised me that possibly 200,000 Angus seed stock could possibly be affected by this problem which is reported to be lethal. According

to the American Angus Association releases it is called Curly Calf Syndrome.

Dr. David Steffens of the University of Nebraska, in his release thru the AAA, makes this explanation of the symptoms, "The spine is bent and twisted



in affected calves. The calves are small and appear thin due to limited muscle development. Legs are often rigid and may be hyper extended (common in rear limbs) or contracted. In some calves the rigid limbs result in calving difficulties." He goes on to say "affected calves should be reported to the American Angus Assn. credit in that they immediately sent out to all of their contacts, a notice to report to them any information of unusual physiological problems with calves.

One prominent breeder who recognized the problem in his herd, and from other breeders throughout the world that had used his genetics, reacted quickly and publicly. How difficult this is for the people in the Angus world, and the breeders, who have the problem to quickly, and publicly face it. I commend these folks. Some breeders in the Hereford breed have recently faced a genetic problem of their own. A DNA test for IE was developed by Dr. Jon Beever of the U of Illinois (who is also involved in the effort with the AAA Curly Calf research) for the problem. In Dr Steffens' report, previously mentioned, was also another item of interest, in that the lethal gene of dwarfism in Angus cattle has been identified through research supported

by the AAA. Dr Steffens wrote "that this is an example of what can be achieved through research."

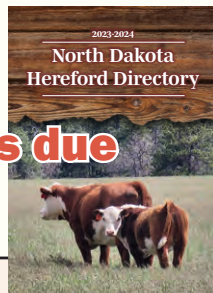
I was a small boy during the depression of the 1930s but I can remember it well.

My Dad was involved in a bank failure that had long term effects on the family; cattle were nearly impossible to sell at any price. It was hard to get any money from a bank. Barter was a common practice, our Mother raised a garden and chickens for food to add to our beef and dairy products (yes, we milked a cow) so not much needed to be purchased. We had no electricity so no cost there, and we used wood for heat. We used teams for the ranch work and they were great as in the sub zero temperatures they started every morning. As I remember, gas was about eight cents per gallon, but we didn't use the car or truck much. I can remember one great day when the owner of a packing company in Butte called Dad and told him he needed some cattle to slaughter. Dad told him we had some for sale and invited him to the ranch.

Mr. Hanson, owner of Hanson Pack showed up in his big Packard (a big, premium car to you younger people)

and brought each of us kids a bag of candy. (We were impressed.) This was the start of a big day for our family. Mr. Hanson looked the cattle over and said, "Mr. Bayers, I can use 10 head of these cattle and I will offer you \$15 per head." My Dad was elated to have an offer as no cattle had been sold for a long spell and he needed the money and quickly accepted. Everybody was happy around our house and things seemed to improve after Mr. Hanson's visit. We had one hired man, Eldon King, who was later Herdsman of the Year, and was paid \$30 per month and he stayed in our house

and ate with us. Regular help, if you could find a job, was \$15 to \$20 per month plus board and room. Eldon was just a lot better than the average man. Jobs were so scarce I can remember men walking down our road and stopping in and asking for meal to get on down the road. My Mother always gave them a meal and they split some wood or other little jobs and moved on after a sincere thank you. This happened several days each week. There was no welfare or unemployment payments then, no FDIC guarantees on your money, just work and work it out the best you can. These tough times leave lasting memories on

people. After our Mother passed away our oldest sister Helen, was clearing out Mother's things when on her bath robe she noticed a pin sticking through and when Helen looked inside the robe she found a roll of money that Mother had put away for the dark days. Her memories of the Depression. Those were tough days and those of us still living will not forget them.

Now we must look forward to better days than we had in the '30s even though we are going through tough times nationally and internationally. We have safeguards today we did not have before and we are dealing on a world

market today. We are tough people, probably not as tough as the '30s bunch but we can recover. We must be optimistic, not defeated, and we must not think someone will bail us out. We will pay the bill, all of us, but we will recover.



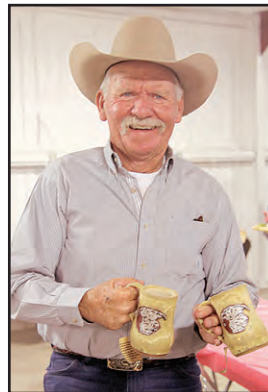

Bruns received the inaugural \$1,500 Livestock Marketeers Scholarship during the 2024 VitaFerm® Junior Nation-

al Hereford Expo (JNHE) in Grand Island, Neb., on July 11. Bruns is a junior at Kansas State University, where he is studying animal sciences and industry and agricultural business. He is a nine-year member of the Nebraska Junior Hereford Association and National Junior Hereford Association (NJHA). He was elected to the NJHA board of directors at the 2024 JNHE. After college, Bruns intends to pursue a career in livestock marketing and hopes to be an auctioneer. He also plans to continue raising cattle with his family while building his own cow herd.

Rohrig received the second \$1,500 Livestock Marketeers scholarship during the Iowa State Fair in Des Moines, IA. Rohrig and his family own a show pig operation. He has shown pigs since he was eight years old and Hereford cattle before that. Rohrig is a member of the Iowa Junior Beef Breed Association Junior Board and the Iowa Swine Jackpot Series. He will be a freshman at Iowa State University, where he plans to major in animal science and agriculture business. He also plans to attend auctioneer school in the near future. Rohrig currently serves as an Iowa

state FFA officer and has career plans of being part of the beef industry, working sales and traveling the state.

The Livestock Marketeers Scholarship fund was established at the organization’s annual Hall of Fame Banquet in 2023. Livestock Marketeers gathered \$23,000 from its members to begin the scholarship fund. Since then, they have added an additional \$20,000 and have increased initial scholarship payouts.
