
"It's back" — was echoed around the grounds at the 2026 National Western Stock Show as exhibitors, families, and spectators returned to Denver for

the "Best 16 days in January," celebrating the 120th anniversary of the iconic stock show. The 2026 event wasn't just a return — it made a statement, blending tradition with transformation and creating moments that will be remem-

bered for decades.

Newly branded as — We are the West; this year's event captured the spirit by connecting the storied past with a modern, expanding vision of

In the NWSS carload show, Dvorak Herefords won Grand Champion with their group of champion senior bull calves sired by JDH AH Lincoln 106H ET, RST Final Print 0016, Birdwell New Standard 2912 ET and JW 1857 Merit 21134. This pen weighed 1,349 lbs. on average, with a weight per day of age (WDA) of 3.34 and average scrotal circumference (SC) measuring 37.50 centimeters.

Landgren Ranch, Bartlett, NE, had the Reserve Grand Champion Carload and champion in the spring bull calf division with a group sired by Land Chief 2097, UPS Voyager, Land Makers Mark 2072ET, Land Frisco 3060, UPS Taylor Made ET and JDH AH Lincoln 106H ET. The group of bulls weighed an average of 1,069 lbs. with a 3.54 WDA and average SC of 34.80 centimeters.



western culture. “The Stock Show is about honoring our roots, inspiring the next generation, and creating memories that last a lifetime,” said Wes Allison, President and CEO as he stepped into his new leadership role.

The excitement showed in the numbers. The previous attendance record of 726,972, set in 2006, was shattered as more than 750,000 people came through the gates in 2026. That momentum carried into more records, where the Junior Livestock Market Auction also set a record, surpassing the previous high by \$423,000. This year’s Grand Champion Junior Market Steer sold for \$320,000 to Bank of Colorado, underscoring any questions about Denver’s commitment to the future of agriculture and the National Western.

Honoring the Roots, Building the Future

Since its founding in 1906 on the site of the notable Denver Union Stockyards, the National Western Stock Show has served producers as a premier annual livestock exhibition. It’s also home to one of the world’s richest professional rodeos, world-class horse

shows, family educational events, and Colorado’s largest western trade show.

For those deeply invested in the beef cattle and seedstock industries, the 2026 event marked the long-awaited unveiling of the show’s redevelopment. Aging facilities faced mounting structural and ventilation challenges,

and the grounds constrained by railroad lines and interstate roads limited growth and modernization. Then when COVID forced cancellation of the 2021 show, uncertainty once again loomed over the future of the historic event.

A core group of Stock Show supporters and board leaders stepped up, led

by longtime agriculture advocate Pete Coors. Coors chaired the Honoring the Legacy capital campaign initiated in 2017, which raised \$150 million to construct a multi-phased rebuild designed to secure the National Western’s future.



Phase one transformed the historic Yards into the Cille and Ron Williams Yards with modern pens and services, along with the HW Hutchinson Family Stockyards Event Center, now home to pen and carload shows and breed sales.

Phase two reached completion in 2026 with the opening of the 30-acre Sue Anschutz-Rodgers Livestock Center, featuring a 5,000-seat arena and a 200,000-square-foot livestock hall with capacity for more than 1,400 head of cattle, strategically located adjacent to the Yards. The same phase also introduced The Legacy — the National Western’s new headquarters and museum — dedicated to preserving the milestones and stories that define the show’s history. A future phase will add a new Equestrian Center to further expand capabilities.

of Hereford shows both pen and showing. The Colyer crew was very happy with the new facilities, where the cattle were stalled, and the new CoBank Show arena. In 42 years, the family showed 21 champions and were one of the first breeders to come back for the inaugural year of the rebuilt pen show.

Roger Stuber, Bowman, ND echoes Colyer's description of the event. "It's the World Series of Hereford shows," he said. Stuber has reached a milestone few can match. In 68 years, he has missed only two National Western Stock Show events — noting that one

absence came in 2021 when the show was canceled. "So really, I've only missed one," he added. Needless to say, he wasn't about to miss the grand opening reveal of the new facilities in 2026. To Stuber, the updates represent an evolution of tradition. Change may bring different results, he noted, but he believes the future is bright and that the stock show will continue to serve as a vital avenue for promoting and marketing Hereford cattle — just as has been witnessed throughout its storied history.



Pete Atkins of Tea, SD, and past president of the American Hereford Association, watched the Hereford show from the new CoBank Arena seating and praised the visibility and technology. “You can see well across all the ringside seating, and the big screens both in the ring and back in the barns help you follow the show,” he said. “The facilities are beautiful – I wasn’t sure what to expect.” However, he commented that many discussions took place along the previous ringside rail, and he wonders how the changes will impact the business that used to occur ringside – time will tell, he believes.

One of the most talked about changes was the green astroturf show ring flooring surface, replacing dirt. The new flooring allows for full evaluation of the feet and walking of the animals, Atkins believes, although he noted some animals do seem to hesitate when walking on it. As a longtime yard exhibitor with Atkins-Delaney Herefords of Lake Benton, MN, he also welcomed improved access between the yards and the new livestock center.

Some exhibitors haul cattle hundreds of miles; however, Coyote Ridge Here-

fords of LaSalle, CO, has the benefit of traveling only one hour for this international event. “We’ve participated in the National Western for more than 30 years; it’s been an invaluable way for our family to showcase our Hereford genetics to commercial ranchers and elite breeders from across the country and internationally,” said managing partner, Hampton Cornelius.

“The new livestock center is world-class; it elevates the show experience and the entire industry’s ability to connect and conduct business at the high-

est levels. The Cornelius family appreciates how the new facilities honor traditions while making everything more walkable and accessible for spectators.”

Just as important, he added, is the opportunity to connect consumers with agriculture. “These facilities open doors for the public to learn where their food comes from.” “This outreach matters,” Klippenstein emphasized, “We must remember we are in the food business, and we need to show our best to those who influence us.”

Connecting with Others

For Kristy Campbell of Eaton, CO, the Stock Show has been important to her family history. She showed steers there as a youth, and her father exhibited the 1963 Champion Catch-a-Calf. This year, the first animal to enter the new CoBank arena was a Hereford Catch-A-Calf entry. Kristy, her husband Jason, and daughter Samantha have shown Herefords in Denver since 2012.

Campbell was impressed by the gorgeous new facilities, the staff’s courtesy, and the improved load-in and load-out process. While she understands there are always a few things learned during the launch of anything new, she values the ability to hold a major livestock show in a metropolitan setting, where it can educate the broad public audience.

“I think at one point there were 40 livestock trailers backed up to the doors to unload, and earlier in the day the entire Hereford industry was parked in the pre-staging lot ready to unload for the show. We were excited to be in the facility, while anxious at the same time, as change always makes it different, and it takes time to adjust.”

One moment stood above others for Campbell – the inaugural Parade of Champions and selection of the Supreme Junior Heifer at the PRCA rodeo semifinal performance. Breed champions from two weeks of junior shows, including the Polled Hereford and Horned Hereford shows, entered the arena in front of a packed crowd. They competed for scholarship awards rang-

ing from \$ 2,500 to \$ 10,000, with all participants receiving financial support and future payouts expected to grow.

“I was choked up as a cattle person seeing our industry on display in front of a huge rodeo crowd — in the same arena where my grandpa rodeoed.” As announcers highlighted each breed, she heard spectators nearby in the audience say, “Look at those beautiful animals.”

It was a great opportunity for kids to see kids and build a connection between agriculture and urban people.

Throughout the week, she makes a point to answer questions and share how food is produced. Consumers sup-

port our industry every day. We owe them that connection.” The money consumers spend on our industry – “we have to have someone buy the cheeseburgers” – allows us to spend dollars on our cattle and our families.”

For many other visitors, the National Western becomes a pilgrimage, a gathering of

generations and friends made over the years. “For many years, I would return to see friends I met and the relationships I built through the cattle business,” Klippenstein said. “It’s a people business way more than just a cattle business.”

Long-time exhibitor, Sheila Jensen of Jensen Hereford Ranch in Courtland, KS, could feel the optimism among exhibitors. “Everyone was happy to be back, happy that they kept it going, that the history can carry forward.” Her family’s ties run deep — her father showed Shorthorns in the late ’60s at the National Western — and she, like many others, is part of the next generation carrying on that tradition. “Everyone is ready for another 120 years,” Jensen said.

Throughout this year’s event, many conversations often drifted back to

memories made in the old Yards and on The Hill — and to parents and grandparents who had walked the aisles and alleys of the National Western Stock Show and showed in the historic buildings. What might they think of today’s facilities many wondered.

The question was answered. National Western 2026. The setting may be new, but for many, the purpose — and the pride — remains the same.


